(D) Inflationary Increase:

Per statute, for FY2022 the Base Student Cost will be increased by an inflationary adjustment equal to 40% of the Base Student Cost for the previous fiscal year times the latest annual rate of inflation as determined by the State Economist. The rate of inflation for the current adjustment to the Base Student Cost is 1.649%. An increase in general funds in the amount of \$9,761,473 is requested. This estimate will be updated once actual FY2020 ADA data is received from school districts.

(E) Funding Restoration:

Due to underfunding during FY2021, an increase is requested in general funds in the amount of \$178,886,887.
