Agency Description and Programs

Section 45-5-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, established the Law Enforcement Officers' Training Academy. The Academy is operated and maintained by the Commissioner of Public Safety for the purpose of providing training facilities for members of the Department of Public Safety and such other law enforcement officers of the state, counties, or municipalities as may schedule the use of the same with the Commissioner.
