Agency Description and Programs

The Department of Agriculture and Commerce administers the program with the advice of the Beaver and Wild Hog Control Advisory Board. The program shall be limited to the control or eradication of beavers only on private lands or public lands, excluding federally owned lands but including lands whereupon easements are granted to a federal entity.
