### STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

House Bill 1593 of the 2008 Regular Session appropriated \$1,547,000 from the Criminal Justice Fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of special judges, chancellors and circuit judges for FY2009. However, due to shortfalls in revenue collections for the Criminal Justice Fund, only \$1,125,773 was received by the Court during FY2009.

As a result of this shortfall, House Bill 1702 of the 2009 Regular Session appropriated \$400,000 from the Budget Contingency Fund. These funds were received in May 2009.

#### OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

House Bill 1593 of the 2008 Regular Session appropriated \$1,547,000 from the Criminal Justice Fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of special judges, chancellors and circuit judges for FY2009. However, due to shortfalls in revenue collections for the Criminal Justice Fund, only \$1,125,773 was received by the Court during FY2009. As a result of this shortfall, House Bill 1702 of the 2009 Regular Session appropriated \$400,000 from the Budget Contingency Fund. These funds were received in May 2009.

House Bill 48 of the 2009 Second Extraordianry Session of 2009 appropriated \$400,000 from the Criminal Justice Fund and \$481,000 from the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund for the purpose of

### I. Program Description:

Mississippi's trial court system consists of two general jurisdiction courts (circuit and chancery) and three (3) limited jurisdiction courts (county, juvenile, and municipal). Twenty (20) chancery courts have jurisdiction over matters involving equity, divorce, alimony, probate, guardianship, and sanity. Chancery courts have exclusive jurisdiction over juvenile matters where there are no county courts. Their jurisdiction over equity matters involving less than \$200,000 is concurrent with county courts. Most chancery court cases are non-jury proceedings, although juries may be impaneled in certain circumstances. Twenty-two (22) circuit courts have original jurisdiction over all civil and criminal matters not vested exclusively in another court. Most circuit court cases are heard by juries, although some circumstances may permit bench trials. Circuit judges also have the power to issue extraordinary writs.

### II. Program Objective:

The objective of this program is the direct support of the constitutionally mandated duties of the trial judges of this state and related personnel. In Fiscal Year 1992, The Department of Finance & Administration transferred the administrative duties and management of funds to the Supreme Court. Such transfer enlarges the program objective to include statewide fiscal management of the salary and support features included in this funding.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 10 Estimated & FY 11 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

### (D) OFFICE/RENT ALLOWANCE:

We are requesting an increase in the trial judge office allowance in the amount of \$198,000 due to underfunding in FY2010. By statute, each of the 99 trial judges is allocated an office allowance expense of \$9,000. Also, the AOC allots \$4,000 to 27 judges to offset the cost of office rent in situations where the county cannot provide the office space for the judge. Based on these factors, the appropriation for FY2010 should have been \$999,000 (99 x \$9,000 + 27 x \$4,000).

Effective January 1, 2011, three new trial judges will be elected (one chancellor and two circuit judges). Therefore, we are requesting an additional \$13,500 in office allowance for these offices. This represents funding for 6 months for each judge (3 x \$4,500)

#### (E) SALARY DEFICIT:

An increase of \$2,048,185 is requested to offset the underfunding for the trial judge support staff for FY2010. In FY2009, the support staff for each trial judge was increased from \$40,000 to \$80,000. The intent of this legislation was to allow each trial judge in the state to have access to a law clerk and during FY2009 the majority of the trail judges were able to hire a law clerk into their staff. The Court request that this funding be replaced in order to avoid layoffs across the state.

### (F) TRAVEL INCREASE:

\$582,400 is requested in this category, which is an increase of \$115,000 or 24.6% above the FY2010 appropriation. \$60,000 of this increase is attributed to the addition of three (3) new trial judges which will take office on January 1, 2011. The remaining \$55,000 is requested to fund the out of state travel for the current 99 trial judges.

In-state travel (\$482,400, increase of \$15,000) is requested to allow judges to travel to court in locations throughout their district, to include meals, mileage, and lodging. This increase is requested to allow the 3 new judges to travel to court in locations throughout their district. It is estimated that each new judge will need approximately \$5,000 to travel six months during FY2011

\$100,000 is requested for Out-of-state travel is requested to allow judges to attend classes and seminars sponsored by the National Judicial College, American Academy of Judicial Education, Mississippi Bar, American Bar Association, Fifth Circuit Federal Court District, Mississippi\Louisiana\Arkansas judicial branches, etc. Included in this amount is \$9,000 which will allow the 3 new judges to attend training sponsored by the National Judicial College. This training is required for all new judges at the Court. No funds were appropriated for out-of-state travel in FY2009. The Court's administrative staff has been meeting with the Governor's office to either find an alternative funding source or receive a deficit appropriation for the shortfall in this category. This request would provide funding at a rate

### (G) MMRS FEES:

MMRS Fees per Finance and Administration - \$4,033

An increase of \$4,033 is requested for MMRS fees per the July 30, 2009 memo from the Department of Finance adn Administration. These fees are projected at \$18,327 for FY2010 and \$22,360 for FY2011.

### (H) ON-LINE LEGAL RESEARCH:

Westlaw Contract for On-Line Legal Research - \$890

An increase of \$890 is requested for the Westlaw contract for on-line legal research. The contract amount for FY2010 is \$29,523 and will increase to \$30,413 in FY2011. This subscriber agreement allows judges, staff attorneys and law clerks to access Westlaw and CD-ROM libraries for legal research purposes. These on-line research charges are shared with the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Administrative Office of Courts.

IV. Additional program activities that will result from increased funding requested in Columns 16-25 (MBR-1-03) and specified Budget Decision Unit Columns (MBR-1-03-A):

#### (I) NEW TRIAL JUDGES:

Three (3) new trial judges will take office on January 1, 2011. A total of \$388,200 is requested to support these new positisons. These cost are for 6 months only and the amount to be requested in FY2012 will be increased accordingly.

Salaries: \$314,700 is requested:

\$194,700 is needed to fund these 3 positions for the 6 months of January 1, 2011 to June 30, 2011. \$120,000 is needed to fund the support staff for the 3 new trial judges for the 6 months of January 1, 2011 to June 30, 2011.

Travel: \$60,000 is requested.

\$60,000 is needed to provide reimbursement for the new judges for travel to and from the courthouses. The funds will also provide for Judicial College training for each of the new judges. This training is required by the Court for all new judges.

Commodities: \$13,500 is requested

\$13,500 is needed to provide each of the 3 judges with \$4,500 in office allowance for the 6 months of January 1, 2011 to June 30, 2011.

### Narrative Explanation:

The total of \$592,271 represents the 3% reduction required by the budget contingency fund.

Judicial salaries are set by statute and cannot be reduced while the judge is in office. Therefore, any reduction in the salaries category must be taken from the support staff funds alloted to each judge. This amount is also set by statute at \$80,000 per judge. In order to avoid layoffs any reduction in this salaries would have to be absorbed at the county level.

The commodities budget for the trial courts consist only of the office allowance (\$9,000 for 102 judges) and rent allowance (\$4,000 for 27 judges) is also set by statute. Any decrease in this category would affect the ability of the judges throughout the state to operate their offices on a daily basis.

TRIAL JUDGES Narrative

Salaries

A total of \$21,813,300 is requested for this category which is an increase of \$2,550,619 or 13.2% above the FY 2010 appropriation. The overall request includes funding for one-hundred two (102) trial judge salaries (\$13,051,300), senior status and special judge appointments (\$240,000), Complaint Tribunal per diem (\$1,000), a temporary appointment of an additional judge in Hinds county, special judge appointments for Katrina related cases (\$481,000) and an annual support staff allowance per judge (\$8,040,000). Trial Judge salaries are set by statute.

An increase of \$2,235,919 is requested to offset the underfunding of the support staff for the trial judges in FY 2010. In FY 2009, the support staff for each trial judge was increased from \$40,000 to \$80,000. The intent of this legislation was to allow each judge access to a law clerk. During FY 2009 the majority of the trial judges were able to hire a law clerk into their staff. The Court request that this funding be replaced in order to avoid layoffs across the State.

An increase of \$194,700 is requested for compensation for three (3) new judges effective 1/1/2011. The increase is for six months salary and fringe benefits.

The new judges will also require support staff allowance to be funded at \$40,000 per judge (\$120,000) for FY 2011. This is one half the annual allowance per judge.

#### Travel

\$582,400 is requested in this category, which is an increase of \$115,000 or 24.6% above the FY2010 appropriation..

In-state travel (\$482,400, increase of \$15,000) is requested to allow judges to travel to court in locations throughout their district, to include meals, mileage, and lodging. This increase is requested to allow the 3 new judges to travel to court in locations throughout their district. It is estimated that each new judge will need approximately \$5,000 to travel six months during FY2011

\$100,000 is requested for Out-of-state travel is requested to allow judges to attend classes and seminars sponsored by the National Judicial College, American Academy of Judicial Education, Mississippi Bar, American Bar Association, Fifth Circuit Federal Court District, Mississippi\Louisiana\Arkansas judicial branches, etc. Included in this amount is \$9,000 which will allow the 3 new judges to attend training sponsored by the National Judicial College. This training is required for all new judges at the Court. No funds were appropriated for out-of-state travel in FY2009. The Court's administrative staff has been meeting with the Governor's office to either find an alternative funding source or receive a deficit appropriation for the shortfall in this category.

### Contractual Services

\$97,223 is requested in this category. This is an increase of \$4,923 or 5.33% above the FY2010 appropriation.

An increase of \$4,033 is requested for MMRS fees per the July 30, 2009 memo from the Department of Finance and Administration. These fees are projected at \$18,327 for FY2010 and \$22,360 for FY2011.

An increase of \$890 is requested for the Westlaw contract for on-line legal research. The contract amount for FY2010 is \$29,523 and will increase to \$30,413 in FY2011. This subscriber agreement allows judges, staff attorneys and law clerks to access Westlaw and CD-ROM libraries for legal research purposes. These on-line research charges are shared with the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Administrative Office of Courts.

### Commodities

\$1,012,500 is requested in the commodity category for trial judge office operating and office space allowances. This is an increase of \$211,500 or 26.4%. The office allowance is set by statute at \$9,000 annually per judge and the rent allowance is set by statute at \$4,000 annually per judge. (Trial judges are allowed an office space allowance if no county space is provided to them; there are an estimated 27 judges eligible for the office space allowance.) \$198,000 of the requested increase is to restore the deficit created in the FY2010 appropriation and the additional \$13,500 is needed to provide 6 months of office allowance (\$4,500 each) for the 3 new judges..

### Overall\Funding

In FY 2010 the legislature provided \$481,000 in one time funding from the Hurricane Disaster Relief Fund. Since this funding will not be available in FY2011 the overall request is a General Fund increase of \$3,656,042 over the FY2010 appropriation.
