1. Salaries

During FY 2009 the Ethics Commission began implementing new roles under the Public Records Act and Open Meetings Act. These added responsibilities have brought an increased work load. The Commission's budget request for FY 2011 contains funding for an additional attorney position.

In FY 2009 the Commission's assistant director resigned and returned to private sector law practice. In order to absorb budget cuts imposed in FY 2009 and expected in FY 2010 without terminating staff, the position of assistant director was left vacant for approximately eight (8) months. The budget request for FY 2011 anticipates all positions will be filled for the entire fiscal year. No salaries have changed since FY 2008.

2. Travel

The Ethics Commission is actually REDUCING its request for travel funding due to the purchase of two (2) used sedans in August 2008. Previously, the Commission paid mileage reimbursement for all travel. During FY 2009 the savings which resulted from the vehicle purchase paid for the purchase price and operating cost of the vehicles AND saved approximately \$4,000 in General Fund appropriations.

3. Contractual Services

The Contractual Services category for FY 2010 contains a one-time expenditure of \$54,520 which will be paid to the Department of Information Technology Services for implementation of a statutorily mandated system for electronically filing Statements of Economic Interest.

The increase in Contractual Services between FY 2009 to FY 2011 is primarily attributable to an anticipated rent increase resulting from the sale of the Commission's current office. Pursuant to Senate Bill 2887 enacted during the 2008 Regular Session, the Legislature authorized the Department of Finance and Administration to sell the building in which the Commission currently resides. While the 2011 budget request includes an increase for minor object code 61470, Capitol Facilities - Rental, the Commission does not yet know where it will relocate or how much space will ultimately be rented to the Commission. Staff for the Commission and the Department of Finance and Administration have discussed the space needs of the Commission and availability of adequate state owned space.

4. Commodities

The Ethics Commission requests a modest increase in the Commodities category to cover rising fuel prices.

5. Vehicles

As discussed above the purchase of two (2) used sedans has resulted in dramatic savings in the Travel category. However, usage trends indicate one of the Commission's vehicles will need replacing in FY 2011, according to replacement models recommended by the Department of Finance and Administration, Office of Fleet Management. The vehicles currently in inventory were purchased by DFA - Office of Surplus Property on behalf of the Ethics Commission at an auction of surplus federal government vehicles. We anticipate using the same method to purchase a similar replacement vehicle. Due consideration will be given to purchase price, fuel consumption and maintenance costs, with a goal of providing the greatest utility at the lowest cost to the taxpayer.
