I. Program Description:

Investigation and prosecution of complaints of judicial misconduct and disability pursuant to Section 177A of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, as amended.

II. Program Objective:

To investigate each complaint as completely as possiblie in a timely manner, to prosecute those complaints involving misconduct or disability and to present same to the Mississippi Supreme Court.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 10 Estimated & FY 11 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) Professionalism of Staff:

The Commission on Judicial Performance is again requesting salary increases for its legal staff and its administrative staff. The Commission legal salaries are considerably below the salaries of the District Attorneys which has historically created retention issues. The Commission is seeking to increase its Senior Attorney's salary from \$71,500 to \$81,000 (which is still less than a junior attorney in the DA offices) and to increase its Attorney's salary from \$59,029 to \$65,000. We are also requesting a slight increase for the only administrative position which serves more as an office manager than an Executive Assistant due to the agency's size and complexity.

(E) Relocation & Update of Off:

The Commission's lease is expiring in FY10 and it is anticipated that its offices will be relocated. Due to this change, we are seeking increases in the contractual line item for increased rent, increases in the commodities and equipment categories for additional office furniture and supplies to equip the additional space which was not included in the FY10 budget request.

The equipment line item is also being increased to replace out-dated computers and to purchase laptops. Finally, the Wireless equipment category contains an increase to enable the Commission to replace the out-dated communications equipment.

### NARRATIVE 2011 BUDGET REQUEST

#### OVERVIEW

During the past several years, national attention has focused on Mississippi due to judicial misconduct issues. The media attention has increased the public's awareness of the Commission on Judicial Performance. This public attention has expanded the workload of the Commission; however, the funding of the office has not increased proportionately. Several years ago, the Legislature enabled the Commission to receive special fund revenue from court assessments. These revenues were appropriated in order for the Commission to meet its operating expenses. However, since the special funds began to be collected, the General Fund appropriation has declined each year since FY05.

The revenue collected from court assessments provides only one-third of the required funding for Commission operations. Due to mandated budget cuts in past several years, the special fund revenue has had to absorb additional operation expenses. The special funds cannot support additional General Fund reductions. The Commission is requesting additional General Fund revenue for its FY11 operations.

The Commission on Judicial Performance has historically not been fully funded and has to request an annual deficit appropriation for the past several years. We are requesting to be fully funded at the beginning of the year in order to operate as effectively as possible.

PERSONAL SERVICES - SALARY \$453,299

The Commission employs two attorneys to handle the cases of judicial misconduct. The salaries of these two employees are \$71,500 and \$51,950 respectively. The starting salary for a staff attorney in a District Attorney's office is in excess of \$80,000 and a senior attorney's salary within the District Attorney's office is in excess of \$86,000. At this time, the Commission is not requesting compensation at the same level as the District Attorneys but is requesting an increase for each of its attorneys in order to address staff retention. This request was included in the FY09 and the FY10 request and funds were not appropriated. We are again requesting the attorney salaries to be increased to \$81,427 and \$65,000 respectively.

Additionally, we are seeking a slight increase for the Executive Assistant position. Since the Commission employs only five staff members, the majority of whom travel, the Executive Assistant performs many more duties than that of a clerical employee. This position maintains the case track system, responds to complaints received, maintains the Commission minutes, and serves as Office manager. Based on these tasks, the position should be compensated at a higher level. We are seeking to increase this salary to \$45,000. This request was also included in the FY10 request and was not funded.

The total salary increase requested including fringe benefits is \$37,069, which is less than the increase requested for FY10. The reduction in the decrease is due to the fact that the Commission will be employing a new Executive Director who will be compensated at a rate closer to the start step of that position.

TRAVEL \$ 55,000

The Commission is requesting the same salary level as received in its FY10 appropriation.

CONTRACTUAL \$ 120,377

The Commission is requesting a three percent increase in its contractual line item primarily due to the fact that the building lease is expiring. The building manager has informed the Commission that the current rate will not be extended. The cost of office space will increase whether or not the offices are relocated.

## COMMODITIES \$ 9,450

The expenditures in the commodity line items during the past two years and that anticipated for the current year equate to approximately \$1,000 per employee per year. The Commission has not been able to maintain supplies needed for day-to-day operations. In addition, the Commission will require additional commodity purchases due to the potential relocation of its offices when the space is advertised for lease.

#### CAPITAL OUTLAY \$ 10,000

The Commission did not have any equipment expenditures in FY07 or in FY09 and only spent \$2,275 in this category in FY08. The FY10 equipment expenditures are estimated at \$5,000 for FY10. The four year average for equipment expenditures is \$1800. This means that the equipment throughout the office is outdated. In addition, furniture may need to be purchased due to relocation of the offices. We are requesting a budget of \$10,000 in order to replace outdated computers and to add laptops for the traveling employees.

We are also requesting \$250 for the purchase of wireless devises for the traveling employees.

In order to fund this request, the Commission will be required to expend cash reserves and increase its general fund appropriation. The criminal assessment fees have assisted in funding the Commission: however, the revenue collected from this has not been sufficient to meet the additional needs of the agency operations.
