FEDERAL FUNDS

The Mississippi Gaming Commission is a participant in a Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement with the U.S. Department of Justice. When the Mississippi Gaming Commission participates in a law enforcement activity in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Justice, we are entitled to an equitable-share of the federally forfeited assets. To remain in compliance with the agreement, the Commission must use such funds for law enforcement purposes only, in accordance with the statutes and guidelines that govern equitable sharing. It is further stipulated that these assets may only be used to augment the law enforcement budget and not to supplant it. Therefore, the fund balance due to seized and forfeited funds can only be used above and beyond our normal operating budget.

STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

3187 Investigations

The Mississippi Gaming Commission has adopted regulations that authorize the Commission to charge monies for various work products, which are necessary to carry out the duties given to the Commission and to comply with Statutes set forth in the Gaming Control Act. The various fees charged are for personal investigations, compliance audits, corporate security investigations, work permitting, associated equipment reviews, firmware testing, and gaming laboratory reviews.

The investigative fund balance at the end of each fiscal year is comprised of many different elements such as carried over fund balances, unused investigative deposits, revenue in excess of estimates and balances created from budget cuts over original appropriations. The revenue stream generated by the activities of the Commission is not based on amounts to be paid annually. Fees from activities such as investigations and/or the work permitting process are generated every three years or every ten years. Therefore, ending cash balances need to be maintained in order to have sufficient funding for the years in which the revenue cycle due to renewals is low.

3188 Charitable Bingo

In the Gaming Control Act, the Mississippi Gaming Commission is also tasked with the oversight and enforcement of the Charitable Bingo Laws. Along with this task, the Commission was given the authority to assess various fees associated with this oversight. These fees include but are not limited to License Fees, Bingo Revenue Fees, Pull-tab Fees, and Machine Fees. Section 97-33-101 of the Charitable Bingo Law states:

"All fees and fines collected by the commission pursuant to Sections 97-33-51 through 97-33-203 shall be deposited into a special fund to be known as the "Charitable Bingo Fund," which is hereby created in the State Treasury. The monies in such fund shall be used exclusively to support the activities of the commission related to the regulation of the Charitable Bingo Law, upon appropriation by the Legislature. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on amounts in such special fund shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund."

Any cash balance remaining in the Charitable Gaming Fund is unexpended revenues not for use in any other program.

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests a continuation budget of \$10,854,306 for Fiscal Year 2011. This request reflects an overall decrease of \$1,904,061 from our Fiscal Year 2010 appropriation. The MGC does not foresee any expansion of activities or services, but seeks to maintain the level of regulatory services necessary to carry out the responsibilities placed on the MGC in the Gaming Control Act. At the MGC's current level of funding, there are areas which need to be enhanced in order to maintain the level of integrity the State of Mississippi has established in the gaming industry's regulatory environment. A lack of funding leads to staffing shortages, limited travel and a shortage of contractual funds to adequately train and develop law enforcement and auditing staff, and limits commodity funds which interrupts the continuation of business.

No General Funds are requested for Fiscal Year 2011. The funds will be realized through firmware testing and fees associated with investigation, associated equipment reviews, gaming laboratory reviews, audits, etc.

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests to have language in the Fiscal Year 2011 appropriation bill to continue to have the ability to escalate and expend funds from any proceeds arising from the participation in seizures of illegal gaming activities. These monies will be awarded to the MGC by the county and municipal courts. The use of the funds is limited to law enforcement purposes, excluding salaries.

The Major Object Categories affected by the budget request are detailed as follows:

PERSONAL SERVICES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission is requesting an increase of \$96,439 in the Major Object Category Personal Services. This increase is requested for anticipated reclassifications of enforcement agent and accountant/auditor professional pins, expected educational benchmarks, and maintenance of the MGC's allocated positions. Further detail will be addressed in the individual program narratives.

TRAVEL:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase/decrease in the Major Object Category Travel for Fiscal Year 2011.

CONTRACTUAL SERVICES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a \$2,000,000 decrease in the Major Object Category Contractual Services for Fiscal Year 2011. The amount allocated to this category was increased by \$2,000,000 for Fiscal Year 2010 during the Special Legislative Session. The MGC does not anticipate the need for this money in Fiscal Year 2010.

COMMODITIES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase in the Major Object Category Commodities. Level funding in this category should allow the MGC to carry out the responsibility placed on the MGC by the Gaming Control Act.

CAPITAL OUTLAY:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase/decrease in the Major Object Category Capital Outlay Equipment for Fiscal Year 2011.

VEHICLES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase in the Major Object Category Vehicles for Fiscal Year 2011. However, in order to carry out the responsibilities placed on the MGC by the Gaming Control Act, enforcement agents, auditors, and compliance officers must frequently drive to both casinos and charitable gaming facilities for regulatory purposes. Many vehicles in the MGC's fleet have reached high mileages, which in turn, increase the amount necessary for repairs and maintenance that have to be done. The \$96,000 requested for Fiscal Year 2011 will allow the MGC to purchase approximately six vehicles and to replace some that are in disrepair approaching eight to twelve years old.

WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a decrease of \$500 in the Major Object Category Wireless Communication Devices for Fiscal Year 2011. The appropriation granted for Fiscal Year 2010 allowed the agency sufficient wireless communication devices.

SUBSIDIES, LOANS, & GRANTS:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase/decrease in the Major Object Category Subsidies, Loans, & Grants for Fiscal year 2011.
