The Section 110 Grant, or Basic Support Grant, is administered in the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind and is granted from the Rehabilitation Services Administration under the US Department of Education. This grant is designed to provide services to Mississipians with Disabilities. This group is growing in number and the costs of services needed to rehabilitate them are increasing each year. The Federal Government accounts for these increasing numbers and costs by making more Section 110 funds available each year. We are requesting an increase in FY 2011 Office of Vocational Rehabilitation General Fund Appropriations of \$284,141 and Special Fund Authority of \$1,049,855 to cover the increase in this federal grant. Of this amount, Decision Unit E. makes up \$217,922 of the requested General Fund increase and \$805,185 of the requested Special Fund Authority increase. These increased funds would be used to cover the increases in client served as well as the costs of providing services. The remaining part of the requested increase is accounted for in the increases in Salaries, Travel and Commodities.

MDRS is requesting an increase in Personnel Services in Reallocations/Reclassification (\$181,710) for the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation. These have been fully listed and justified in the FY 2010 Human Resources Needs Narrative and forwarded to the State Personnel Board.

The skyrocketing cost of fuel has had a direct impact on our Travel and Commodity budgets. Since many employees of the Office of Support Services are required to travel to meet with clients or staff members that are housed across the state of Mississippi the need for fuel costs has increased. Personal mileage has increased which inturn has increased our travel budget. Additionally, the increase in gas prices has increased our Commodity budget due to payments made to Fuelman related to the utilization of state vehicles. Therefore, to ensure that staff in the field are properly supervised and trained as well as the assurance that clients are being properly served, the need for an increase in our Travel budget and Commodity budgets are extremely important.

Narrative Explanation:

The majority of state funding associated with this appropriation unit is used to match the Section 110 grant which has a 21.3% match. Therefore, a cut of \$234,511 would result in a loss of federal funds of \$866,480 and a total loss to the OVR program of \$1,100,991. The Section 110 program contains a Maintenance of Effort (MOE) requirement regarding the level of state funds utilized each year. A loss of state funding in this appropriation unit would result in our agency becoming noncompliant with this MOE requirement. As a consequence, such a reduction would not only affect our current federal grant, but would impact future year grants due to the affect on our grant base from FY2011 forward.

In addition to the loss of federal funds, this funding could require the agency to reduce its Subsidy, Loans and Grants line in this appropriation unit which involves the funding we spend on our clients throughout the State of Mississippi.
