FY 2009 was a renewal year for the Commission. A total of 527 licenses were renewed, 326 instate and 203 out of state. It was a successful renewal as most states only renewed at a rate of 50 to 65 percent and ours was above 80 percent. The Continuing Education Seminar attendence was improved as some states that require continuing education have ceased to provide the seminars.
