House Bill 1490 appropriated \$376,758 from the Court of Appeals Special Fund. The fund had a balance of \$108,251 as of June 30, 2011. These funds are the remaining balance of the transfer from the budget contingency fund made in FY2010. In order to provide the balance needed for the FY2012 appropriation, HB1490 allows for a transfer from the Drug Court Special Fund. This transfer will be made when the funds are required. As we anticipate to fully expend these funds in FY2012, there will be no special funds available for use by the Court of Appeals in FY2013. Therefore we are requesting that they be fully funded with general funds in FY2013.

I. Program Description:

The Court of Appeals ("COA") was created during the 1993 Legislative Session to alleviate the escalating workload of the Supreme Court of Mississippi. COA has the judiciary power to determine and dispose of any appeal or other proceedings assigned by the Supreme Court. The jurisdiction of the COA is limited to those matters which have been assigned by the Supreme Court.

II. Program Objective:

The primary objective of this program is to provide efficient and timely disposition of all matters and court filings brought before the Supreme Court.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 12 Estimated & FY 13 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) Salaries:

In FY2012, the employers match for the retirement system increased to 12.93% on January 1, 2011. An additional \$21,345 is required in salaries to cover this increase for FY2013. Also, we are requesting that 100% of this category be funded from general funds.

(E) Contractual Services:

A total increase of \$52,931 is requested in this category which consist of the following:

An additional \$6,000 is requested for employee training. Three new appellate judges have taken office and must attend mandatory training in Reno, NV. Court of Appeals was underfunded in this category in the FY2012 appropriation.

An additional \$8,380 is requested for equipment maintenance repair needed to our JAV courtroom video system. Because we have added an additional Court of Appeals courtroom, our maintenance contract with JAV has increased. The system is vital to the security of all employees and visitors within the building and to document court proceedings.

An additional \$38,551 is needed in professional fees due to the Department of Finance and Administration for additional security services provided to the Gartin Building.

(F) Equipment:

An additional \$22,000 is requested in equipment to replace and update antiquated inventory within the Court of Appeals. These include a new file server for the Court, four (4) new scanners and new laptops for the Court of Appeals judges.

The Supreme Court Clerk provides court related services and critical administrative functions in organizing, managing, and maintaining the effective operation of the state's appellate judiciary. The Clerk's Office is maintained within the framework of the statutes, rules, and regulations enacted by the Legislature and promulgated by the Supreme Court.

II. Program Objective:

The primary objective of the Supreme Court Clerk's Office is to administer a timely and efficient cas flow management system for all case filings received by the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals. The Supreme Court determines which cases will be assigned to the Court of Appeals. Each case appealed to the Supreme Court is processed twice in the Clerk's Office. Upon receipt of the Notice of Appeal, tracking of the record preparation and the timely filing of briefs begins. When the decision is rendered, the case is returned to the Clerk's Office for dissemination of the opinion, issuance of the mandate, and preparation of the record for storage. This office must calendar all filings promptly and determine compliance with the rules of the Court, including any jurisdictional requirements and framework. The progess of appeals, motions, and discretionary review matters are tracked statewide on a daily basis. Funding for this program is reflected under the Supreme Court Administrative Office.

The Court of Appeals was created effective January 1993 to alleviate the escalating workload of the Supreme Court. The Court of Appeals, composed of ten (10) judges, is the state's only intermediate court and has the power to determine or otherwise dispose of any appeal or other proceeding assigned to it by the Supreme Court. The jurisdiction of the Court of Appeals is limited to those matters assigned to it by the Supreme Court.

For FY2013, a total of \$5,484,657 is requested. This is an increase of \$96,276 or 1.78% above the FY2012 appropriation. A summary of this request is as follows:

Personal Services - Salaries

\$4,406,242 is requested in this category which is an increase of \$21,345 or 0.48% above the FY2012 appropriation. The increase is needed to offset the PERS employers match which increased from 12.00% to 12.93% on January 1, 2011.

Personal Services - Travel

\$363,400 is requested in the travel category.

In-state travel is requested at \$338,400 for expense allowances and mileage for judges and for additional expenses to allow judges and support staff to attend various in-state meetings/conferences. MS Code Section 25-3-43 allows judges to receive an expense allowance, in lieu of travel reimbursements, based on the expense rate allowed federal government employees in Jackson. A rate of \$123.00 per day was used for projecting these costs and was applied to the 240 maximum days per judge per year, while attending to judicial duties in Jackson. These earnings are subject to employer match on social security and on retirement (if employed on or before December 31, 2003).

\$25,000 is requested for out-of-state travel to allow judges to attend various judicial training classes, appellate judge seminars, and conferences.

No increase is requested in this category.

Contractual Services

\$674,315 is requested in this category, which is an increase of \$52,931 or 8.51% above the FY2012 appropriation. Below is an explanation of this request, along with the reasons for the requested increases:

A. Tuition, Rewards, and Awards

\$9,000 is requested for employee training for registration fees for various appellate conferences/seminars and the annual meeting of the Mississippi Bar Association and tuition associated with judicial training classes. This is an increase of \$6,000 which will allow the three (3) newest appeallate judges to attend the required training sponsored by the Judicial College in Reno, NV.

B. Communications, Transportation, and Utilities

\$400 is requested for postage; \$50 is requested for freight. Postage charges are requested for mailing court opinions to law schools; correspondence to attorneys, trial judges and court reporters regarding supplementation of records; personnel correspondence; etc. Freight charges are for the delivery of various books needed for the Court's library of legal reference materials and for shipping computer components. There is no increase requested in this area.

C. Rents

A total of \$525,148 is requested for this category.

\$516,398 is requested for office rent in the Gartin building, per our lease agreement with the Department of Finance and Administration. No increase is requested in this category.

Also included in rents is \$8,750 for the rental of two (2) copy machines. This is not an increase above the FY2012 appropriation.

D. Repairs and Service

\$8,380 is requested in this category to cover the annual maintenance agreement with Jefferson Audio Visual for the cameras and video equipment installed in the new Court of Appeals courtrooms. The system is vital to the security of all employees and visitors within the building and to document court proceedings. This was unfunded in FY2012.

E. Fees, Professional, and Other Services

\$65,612 is requested for support costs to Finance and Administration for SAAS accounting system charges associated with processing receipts, warrants, payment vouchers and purchase orders (\$674); MMRS Revolving Fund Fees (\$4,500); State Personnel Board fees (\$2,052); and fees to the Department of Finance and Administration for security services at the Gartin Building (\$58,386).

An increase of \$38,551 is requested for our security services provided by the Department of Finance and Administration to ensure the safety of our employees and visitors.

F. Other Contractual Services

A total of \$29,100 is requested for this category. \$3,200 is requested for the annual tort claim assessment, \$14,000 for the judge's professional liability insurance policies, and \$11,900 for dues including judges' memberships to the Mississippi Bar Association, Mississippi Bar Foundation, American Bar Association, Magnolia Bar Association, and Council of Chief Judges of State Court of Appeals, MS Bar Association dues for the twenty (20) law clerks and five (5) attorneys assigned to the Court of Appeals are also included in this request. No increase is requested in this category.

G. Data Processing

A total of \$36,625 is requested for this category. \$900 is requested for ITS professional services. \$5,350 is requested for payments to the state computer center for Capitol Complex network charges, ADABASE usage, disk storage, batch processing, CICS usage and state-wide backbone costs. \$2,400 is requested for new software and installation with the Court of Appeals. \$17,800 is requested for ITS local telephone service, \$150 for ITS long distance services, \$1,375 for private line charges for judges' home computers and \$7,800 for public network access charges for on-line legal research per our contract with Westlaw. Maintenance and repair costs of \$850 include maintenance of the audio/video system which provides internet access to court proceedings and maintenance contracts on color printers. No increase is requested in this category.

Increases requested for FY2013 are \$6,000 for employee training for newly elected appellate judges to attend judicial training classes; 8,380 for office equipment maintenance to our JAV courtroom video system; and \$38,551 for security services provided to the Gartin building by Capitol Facilities.

Of the \$674,315 requested for contractual services in FY2013, \$558,774 or 83% is budgeted for services provided by state agencies to include office rent, SAAS and MMRS fees, State Personnel Board assessments, tort claim assessments, services charges to the state computer center, and ITS telephone billings.

Commodities

\$18,700 is requested in this category, which is no increase above the FY2012 appropriation. Below is an explanation of this request:

\$4,500 is requested for printed materials to include envelopes, stationery, the annual report and various other reports; \$8,700 for reproduction supplies (primarily toner for copiers and laser printers); \$2,000 for routine office supplies; \$3,000 for paper supplies for copy machines, laser printers, etc.; \$300 for library books for use as legal references by judges and their staff; and \$200 for other supplies.

Equipment

\$22,000 is requested in this category to replace laptops and scanners used by the Court of Appeals judges and staff as well as the purchase of a new file server for use by the entire court. No funds were appropriated for equipment in FY2012.

Subsidies, Loans and Grants

No funding is requested in this category.

Funding

In FY2012, the legislature funded the Court of Appeals with \$376,758 in special funds. This will completely exhaust the balance in the Court of Appeals special fund. Therefore, we are requesting that FY2013 be funded from 100% General Funds.
