The Fund is for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Office of Capital Defense Counsel and fees and expenses of private counsel in death penalty eligible cases. The current assessment is \$2.89 on each conviction.

This assessment generated in excess of \$1.3 million in FY 2011. It is estimated that the current assessment amount will generate approximately the same amount in FY12.

The assessment amount will have to be increased to fully fund the Capital Defense Litigation Act of 2000.
