(D) Section 110 Increases:

The Section 110 Grant is used in the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind and is the Basic Support Grant from the Department of Education for rehabilitation of disabled Mississippians. This group is growing in number and the costs of services needed to rehabilitate them are increasing each year. The Federal Government accounts for these increasing numbers and costs by making more Section 110 funds available each year. We are requesting an increase in FY 2013 Office of Vocational Rehabilitation General Fund Appropriations of \$364,543 and Special Fund Authority of \$1,346,928 to cover the increase in this federal grant. Of this amount, Decision Unit D makes up \$315,864 of the requested General Fund increase and \$1,167,067 of the requested Special Fund Authority increase. These increased funds would be used to cover the increased volume of clients served as well as the costs of providing services to those clients.

(E) Human Resource Needs:

MDRS is requesting an increase in Personnel Services related to reclassifications/reallocations for the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation in the amount of \$228,540. These have been fully listed and justified in the FY 2013 Human Resources Needs Narrative and forwarded to the State Personnel Board.

Narrative Explanation:

The majority of the state funding associated with this appropriation unit is used to match the Section 110 federal grant which has a 21.3% match. Therefore, a cut of \$234,511 would result in a loss of federal funds of \$866,480 and a total loss to the OVR program of \$1,100,991. The Section 110 program contains a Maintenance of Effort requirement regarding the level of state funds utilized each year. A loss of state funding in this appropriation unit could result in our agency being placed on noncompliance with this Maintenance of Effort requirement which would not only affect our current federal grant but also future years grants as the MOE requirement would reduce our grant base from FY2013 forward.

In addition to the loss of federal funds, this funding coud require the agency to reduce its Subsidies, Loans, and Grants line in this appropriation unit which involves the funding we spend on our clients throughout the State of Mississippi.
