PERS is requesting a total of \$10,500,000 in 2013 to fund our technology system upgrade. We are committed to pursuing the most economical avenues for adequate technological support of pension benefit administration. PERS' current programming language, Forte, is no longer a supported development platform. Enhancements to the Forte language, security patches and operating system are no longer available. In addition, the current programming and technical architecture does not support web-enabled functionality and is very difficult to integrate with third-party software and newer operating systems. PERS must continue to address the demands of our customers, as well as changes in technology, to effectively support the processing of pension benefits.

To date, PERS has engaged L. R. Wechsler, LTD., a technology consulting firm which specializes in project management and oversight of pension fund technology solutions. We issued vendor Request for Proposals for the new pension administration system. The successful bidder was CedarCrestone Inc. We are ten months into a three-year project with an estimated implementation date of the first quarter of 2013. PERS requests \$9,800,000 for contractual services and \$700,000 for equipment.
