# FEDERAL FUNDS

Federal Grants are used for callback salary and fringe benefits. Officers work overtime on their days off to enforce the laws on Mississippi highways at points of saturation. DPS also receives several Homeland Security grants to be allocated to municipalities, counties, and local government to assist in terrorism prevention and Emergency Preparedness.

# STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

The Governor awarded DPS \$7,300,000.00 under ARRA Agreement Number 711-SFSF; funds under this agreement are to be used to free up DPS funds to hold a Trooper school in the calendar year 2012.

# **OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS**

Fund 3716 - Driver Services Fees collected to defray the operating cost of the Division of Highway Safety Patrol and the Division of Support Services.

Fund 3710 - Highway Safety Patrol's portion of Court granted forfeitures to make necessary purchases in the area of law enforcement and supply matching funds for enforcement grants.

Consolidated Funds: Fund 371A - Additional reinstatement fee for DUI used to fund MS Highway Safety Patrol Retirement System.

Fund 3717 - Fees collected to administer the weapons permit law.

Fund 3719 - Fees collected for issuing salvage certificate of title on vehicles. Fees are used for administration and support to the MS Highway Patrol.

Fund 371B - Special photo fees added to licenses and identification cards to pay costs incurred for photo licenses.

Fund 371C - Special fund to collect monies from original/renewal of operators and commercial drivers licenses. Fees are used for purchase of Mississippi Highway Patrol Cars, communcation, and weapons.

Fund 371J - Additional fee of \$10.00 for first time traffice violators. Fees collectede will defray the cost incurred by the Department of Public Safety - Highway Patrol in maintaining the nonpublic record of persons who are eligible for participation.

Fund 371M - Special fund to collect monies to support an Information Exchange Network to allow sharing of "booking" information.

I. Program Description:

Program Description

The Enforcement Division of the Mississippi Highway Patrol is responsible for enforcing all traffic and drug laws on state and federal highways. The Enforcement Program includes upgrading the Enforcement Division to reduce the number of fatalities on state and federal highways and to improve highway safety in general.

II. Program Objective:

To increase the number of DUI arrests, seat belt citations, speeding citations and other citations for moving-hazardous violations in an effort to reduce fatalities and other high-injury producing motor vehicle crashes. The Mississippi Highway Patrol will continue its Lifesaver program which is a series of enforcement details set up in high-risk areas where unsafe drivers are ticketed and/or arrested. "Call back" details, where officers work when they would ordinarily be off-duty, will be held monthly, especially during major holiday periods. Joint enforcement details are worked in conjunction with the Public Service Commission to increase enforcement of laws regulating commercial vehicles. All of these programs are designed to reduce fatal and injury-producing motor vehicle crashes on state and federal highways.

- (D) Program Continuation:

The backlog of needed equipment grows each year that we do not keep pace with our scheduled replacement cycle. Other increases in the enforcement program include funding for a trooper school and all associated costs with the school and equipping new troopers once they graduate.

# NARRATIVE 2013 BUDGET REQUEST

# DPS - Highway Patrol

Name of Agency

The Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol budget is subdivided into two (2) programs; Enforcement and Driver Services. Enforcement

The Enforcement Division of the Mississippi Highway Patrol is responsible for enforcing all traffic and drug laws on state and federal highways. The Enforcement Program includes upgrading the Enforcement Division to reduce the number of fatalities on state and federal highways and to improve highway safety generally. MHP objectives include an increase in the number of DUI arrests, seat belt citations, speeding citations and other citations for

moving-hazardous violations in an effort to reduce fatalities and other high-injury producing motor vehicle crashes. The Mississippi Highway Patrol will continue its Lifesaver program which is a series of enforcement details set up in high-risk areas where unsafe drivers are ticketed and/or arrested. "Call back" details, where officers work when they would ordinarily be off-duty, will be held monthly, especially during major holiday periods. Joint enforcement details are worked in conjunction with the Public Service Commission to increase enforcement of laws regulating commercial vehicles. All of these programs are designed to reduce fatal and injury-producing motor vehicle crashes on state and federal highways.

We are requesting a significant increase in this budget due to the following:

The MHSP is authorized 650 enforcement positions. As of June 30, 2010, the number of filled enforcement positions is 528, thus resulting in 122 vacant positions. With this reduction in the number of active enforcement offices, it is imperative that DPS conduct two (2) large classes or three (3) reasonably sized classes through the Training Academy (MLEOTA). Based on previous classes, the cost to train, graduate, equip, and pay the monthly salary to a cadet while training is over \$100,000.00. Classes will create an increase in the following major object categories: Personal Services, Travel, Contractual, Commodities, and Equipment.

Additionally, there are educational benchmarks that are due but there is no funding available to pay. There is both FSLA overtime pay due and compensatory overtime pay due; again, inadequate funding for paying the officers. There are also reclassifications earned but not awarded due to inadequate funding.

Continued inadequate funding for the enforcement program will adversely affect the public safety of citizens of this state as well as traveling visitors through our state.

#### **Driver Services**

The Driver Services program provides for the issuance of driver licenses, identification cards, and the suspension of driving privileges. The program is the repository for motor vehicle accident reports and administers the motor vehicle inspection program. The objective of this program is to ensure qualifications and eligibility of current and potential drivers and to provide accurate and current driver related documents. Verification is done to ensure that motor vehicle inspection stations perform inspections in compliance with state statutes.

Driver Services has undertaken two significant initiatives during the last fiscal year. They are first, the implementation of Kiosks in multiple locations statewide and secondly, the implementation of a Point of Sale (POS) system to replace an antiquated sale system. These two systems are critical to improving the service we provide the citizens of this state with regard to all aspects of the Drivers Services branch. This is not limited to drivers' licenses but includes identification cards and gun permits, just to name a few more.

Another aspect of the MHSP budget for both programs is the cyclic replacement of a significant portion of the fleet. Inadequate funding in the past has resulted in a backlog of replacement needs. Many vehicles are above the desired mileage mark and the situation perpetuates each year that we cannot replace 150-200 vehicles per year. During FY 2010, we replaced 62 vehicles. This is far short of the annual replacement amount, which creates the replacement backlog previously mentioned.

Further problems are created by increases in commodities caused by the steep increase in fuel costs, tires, and petroleum products due to rising oil prices and the ever increasing costs of technology needed to properly administer the operations of both the enforcement and driver services functions of the department. Summary

It is imperative that the MHSP receives adequate funding for both of its programs. Continued inadequate funding will significantly and adversely affect the effectiveness that the MHSP can provide its services to the citizens of this state and to traveling visitors.
