It was the 16th strongest Atlantic hurricane ever recorded, killing more than 200 Mississippians and causing more than \$3 billion worth of Public Assistance funding to rebuild the damaged areas. SB 3037 established the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund and appropriated \$268,000,000 to defray the state share of any federal-matching grant requirements for Hurricane Katrina and other disasters. The balance remaining in Treasury Fund 37SS is \$103,231,244.
