OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

The 2003 appropriations created a special fund for the Commission. This fund is to be used to ensure the office is fully operational by accepting fees generated from the Criminal Justice Fund.

The fees collected do not generate more than one third of the amount needed to fund the expenses of the Commission. The General Fund appropriation is needed to fully fund the Office and yet it has been decreased even though expenses have increased.

The estimated cash balance from last years budget was estimated to be \$5482.00. Actual cash in the fund on June 30, 2012 was \$89,000. This amount was added to the estimated cash balance in order to fully report the actual cash on hand.

I. Program Description:

Investigation and prosecution of complaints of judicial misconduct and disability pursuant to Section 177A of the Mississippi Constitution of 1890, as amended.

II. Program Objective:

To investigate each complaint as completely as possiblie in a timely manner, to prosecute those complaints involving misconduct or disability and to present same to the Mississippi Supreme Court.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 13 Estimated & FY 14 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) STAFF RAISES:

Staff is not in alignment with other Judicial agencies. Agency has been underfunded for at least 3 years. Requesting funding of attorneys at District Attorney levels like other Judicial agencies. Also requesting funding of investigator at comparable levels and the Executive Assistant. Not requesting salary adjustment for Executive Director.

(E) INVESTIGATIONS:

Due to the fact that the agency has been underfunded for the past few years, the agency has been unable to fully fund investigations of judicial misconduct. Agency is requesting increased funding in travel, contractual and commodity budgets in order to thoroughly investigate judicial complaints.

(F) REPLACEMENT OF AGING VEHIC:

The agency currently has a 2005 vehicle with over 160,000 miles that is used all over the state by one investigator to investigate complaints against judges. We anticipate adding at least 20,000 miles in FY13. The agency will desparately need to replace this vehicle by FY14 as it will be approaching 200,000 miles.

(G) AGING COMPUTERS:

The agency has six computers, some older than ten years old and the most recent one purchased in FY2011. The regulatory agencies suggest replacing these every 3 years. None of the current machines comply with the recommendations of DFA for MAGIC implementation. The agency is requesting funding for replacement of six computers.

The Commission on Judicial Performance is one of the few agencies created through a constitutional amendment; this fact demonstrates the public's desire to enforce standards of judicial conduct and to protect them from judicial misconduct. In addition to performing these functions, the Commission protects the judiciary from unfounded allegations.

Although the Commission performs a vital constitutional function, it has historically been underfunded. The Legislature recognized that additional funding was needed and in 2006 provided the agency to receive revenue from criminal assessments; however, this revenue did not augment the funding of the agency as General Fund appropriations were reduced at the same time. In addition to the reduction of General Funds, the Special Fund appropriation has always been in excess of the actual revenue received. The Commission has been able to operate solely from past deficit appropriations and cost cutting measures that have operating the office at austere levels. The Commission has had no excesses in its budget for years and no additional cuts can be made as all current expenses are for fixed costs such as rent, utilities, services from other state agencies, salaries and Commission meetings. Last year the Legislature began analyzing the criminal assessments but has not yet altered the distribution of the revenue received to more realistically distribute the funds to the agencies based on needs. The Commission is hopeful that this analysis will result in legislation this year that will increase the revenue for the Commission for FY14 and beyond.

The FY14 budget presented for consideration is based on the Commission being fully funded regardless of the source of that funding.

SALARIES \$504,072

The Commission employs two attorneys to process complaints and present materials in the hearings resulting from complaints of judicial misconduct. The compensation of these two employees has never been commensurate with other state agency attorneys. With the passage of the judges and district attorney salary increases in the previous legislative session, the disparity in the salaries is even greater. The attorneys in our office make an average of 15.5% below the District Attorney salaries which go into effective in January 2013.

We are requesting that the salaries of these attorneys be aligned with that paid to other attorneys in the state, especially since they serve in a regulatory capacity. In addition, we are requesting slight increases for the support staff.

The amount needed for Salaries, Fringe Benefits and Per Diem to fund this request is \$504,072.

TRAVEL \$12.000

Over the last few years, the Commission has significantly reduced travel costs. The agency did not spend any money in out of state travel in FY12. The Commission has also reduced the number of Commission meetings, thereby reducing the amount spent in this category. The Commission is requesting a slight increase in funding in the travel category in order to fully function as the Judicial Watchdog of the state with thorough investigations and monthly Commission meetings. Full funding will also allow the staff to attend meetings were they can receive required continuing legal education credits.

CONTRACTUAL \$88,221

The agency's FY14 budget reflects an increase in FY13 funding levels. The FY13 levels do not fully fund the agency and the agency will have to escalate funds in order to meet the actual fixed operating obligations of the agency. The escalation will be funded from the small transfer of funds received from legislation enacted in the prior year. The FY14 request simply funds fixed costs and requests a small increase for court reporters and other obligations associated with thorough investigations.

COMMODITIES \$8275

In order to meet budget reductions, the Commission expended its FY12 funds only for essential office supplies. Over the past two years, the agency has drastically reduced in-state travel due largely to the purchase of a vehicle for

investigations. Much of the commodity budget is now dedicated to fuel costs in place of supplies necessary for maintaining office operations. The agency is requesting a slight increase in funding in Commodities in order to fund rising fuel costs and increased fuel consumption due to more investigations. The increase will also allow the agency to purchase supplies that have not been able to be purchased for the past several years due to the underfunding in this category.

CAPITAL OUTLAY \$9000

The Commission did not have any equipment expenditures in FY07, FY09, FY10, or FY12 and does not have anything budgeted for this category for FY13. Since the Commission has only expended \$709 in this category in the past five years, there will be a dire need for computers to be replaced in FY14. Some of the computers currently being used are 10 years old. We are requesting the replace of all computers in the office to comply with MAGIC requirements and the recommended 3-year replacement schedule.

VEHICLES \$20,000

Two years ago the agency purchased a used vehicle from another state agency. This vehicle has greatly reduced the in-state travel costs. However, this vehicle now has approximately 166,000 miles on it and the agency estimates adding another 20,000+ to the vehicle in FY13. The agency is requesting replacement of this vehicle in FY14 with a new vehicle that is sure to last the agency many years. Without the replacement of the vehicle, the agency may be required to return to reimbursing individuals for use of their Privately Owned Vehicles (POV) which will more than double the travel costs reflected in this budget. Prior to the purchase of the vehicle, the agency expended approximately \$24,000 annually in travel. The vehicle will pay for itself in less than two years based on the current mileage rates for POV travel.

In order to fund this request, the Commission will be required to expend cash reserves and increase its General Fund appropriation unless it receives an increase from the criminal assessment fines.
