FEDERAL FUNDS

All federal funds are generated by individual departments of the College. These funds play a major role in the services that are provided to our students. As a result of Title III funds, a new Fine Arts building has just been completed on the Utica Campus. This facility will provide the community and the campus with a modern facility for teaching and opportunities for the advancement of the arts in rural Hinds County. In addition, the college also used these funds to complete the renovation of space on the Utica campus which serves as a health and wellness facility for students, employees and community members.

The federal college work study program provides funds for many of our students, who might not be able to attend college, if this program was not available.

Our special services grant provides counseling and tutoring to the high school students on weekends and during the summer. In these sessions, the students are introduced to the college environment and are made aware of many programs available to these students.

STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

The EEF monies are very important to community colleges. The funds allow Hinds to continue without making significant cuts to employees and their salaries.

OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

The appropriations of special funds for the community colleges are very important to many programs. They have helped the college develop new programs and offer services to the general public that would not have been feasible. Our workforce development center and our sign language interpreter programs would not have been possible without these funds. The special funds are needed and should be expanded to provide opportunities in other areas.

I. Program Description:

Academic instruction includes formally organized instructional activities based on courses in the Mississippi Community/Junior College Uniform Course Numbering System and Associate Degree Nursing. This includes fall and spring semesters and summer terms and is frequently referred to as university-transfer or college parallel courses.

Career and Technical instruction includes organized programs of study at less than a baccalaureate degree level designed to provide occupational preparation for entry/advancement/reassignment in (to) the labor market. These programs are approved by the MCCB, and typically lead to a Certificate of Completion or an Associate of Applied Sciences degree.

Community and Junior Colleges offer a number of instruction activities other than Academic, Technical and Vocational programs. These formally organized instructional activities include adult basic education and GED preparatory courses; industry services or start-up, up-grade or retraining; secondary school vocational courses, apprenticeships training, special interest and personal improvement courses.

II. Program Objective:

The objective of Academic Instruction is to provide affordable access to courses at the freshman and sophomore level, in the Associate Degree Nursing Program, for personal improvement and personal interest, and to award the associate degree to those who successfully complete the required courses of study. This objective is based on Secton 37-29-1, MCA.

The objective of Career and Technical instruction is to educate, train, and provide guidance for individuals who seek to develop knowledge, skill, and behavioral characteristics necessary for successful employment in occupations not requiring a baccalaureate degree. The program provides a unique opportunity to help students develop the characteristics of success that today's business and industry embrace: clarity of purpose, emphasis on quality, teamwork, a broad technical and academic foundation for effective problem solving, decision-making, and communication at the work site.

In accordance with Section 37-29-1 - to provide to individuals and groups educational measures to help make them capable of living satisfactory lives, consistent with ideals of a democratic society. The instructional objective of the other programs noted above is to provide specially designed programs to targeted populations to meet educational and trainging needs of citizens.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 13 Estimated & FY 14 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) SHIFT IN EEF DUE TO ENROLL:

The College requests this special funding from the EEF funds be increased to offset the increased expenses from enrollment increases seen over the last 3 years.

(E) HEALTH/LIFE:

Additional general funds of \$130,601 are requested to fully fund the cost of health and life insurance. We expect to use \$248,681 of carryover from the prior year. However, additional funds will be needed.

(F) CAREER/TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT:

The College requests funds for expansion of the Dual Enrollment offerings in the Career and Technical areas. The College is currently considering new programs in the Automotive area and Machine Tool programs.
