Current Program Activities will be used for ongoing agricultural research activities in critical need In the following areas:

" Research to determine the market feasibility of certain vegetable crops and meats which can be grown by small family farmers in Mississippi as alternative agricultural enterprises.

" Research and intervention related to healthy life style and obesity prevention and control.

" Research to determine the nutritional value of vegetables crops, fruit crops, and meats which could be grown by Mississippi small farm producers. The ongoing research focuses on discovering genetic and other improvements to agricultural crops and meats that reduce cholesterol, increase proteins and or reduces fat content.

" Research to determine the effects and extent of agricultural contaminants on Mississippi's environmental resources and possible prevention, reduction and amelioration strategies.

"Research to determine the feasibility of deploying alternative energy technologies in public and private enterprises and agencies in Mississippi. Such alternative energy may include fuel cell technology, solar energy, bio-fuel and wind energy.

" Research of the feasibility of exporting selected agricultural products produced in Mississippi in selected international markets

Additional monies for the program would be used to employ badly needed scientists in human nutrition environmental ecology and agricultural bio-technology, building the research information technology infrastructure, underwriter the increase in the cost of utilities and for subscription s to professional journal and for membership in research organizations, enabling scientists and research students to participate in professional conferences, seminars and workshops and also enabling them to services to farmers in the region, to procure research materials, including animal feed, fertilizer, planning materials and small farming tools, and enhancing existing equipment and technology services to increase communicability for our research programs.

Supplementary funds would be used to acquire upgrades to the swine/meat research, production and marketing facility at Church Hill in Jefferson County, matching Federal funds to construct an Animal Science Research Facility

ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY-AGRICULTURE

I. Program Description:

The Agriculture Unit at Alcorn State University is the primary unit responsible for the carrying out of the land-grant functions of the university; namely, learning, research, and extension. This unit also shares with other instructional units the responsibility of carrying out the learning function. The program seeks to create knowledge through research and the adaptation/adoption and dissemination of such knowledge through extension, and the preparation of agricultural science and food professionals through teaching.

II. Program Objective:

The primary objective of the Agriculture Unit is to carry a comprehensive program of agriculture and agriculturally-related basic and applied research, extension/public service, and teaching to meet the needs of farmer, homemakers, rural and urban dwellers, and students who are being prepared for professions in agriculture and agriculturally-related fields in government and the private sector.

The program seeks to assist individuals, especially those with limited resources, in improving their economic conditions and the quality of their lives. A central thrust of the program is assistance to farmers, and leadership and community/economic development through informal education programs and community involvement.

III. Current funding will support personnel services that will result in the institution filling critical positions supporting extension and research programs. Extension clients will be served in rural Mississippi counties as a result of this increase. Also, increased research activities will accelerate the pace of discoveries needed to deliver improved plant and animal varieties, marketing, and human interventions to agricultural program clients. Traveling to ensure more contacts with clients and more dissemination of research through field days and peer workshops and conferences. Securing maintenance contracts on research and demonstration equipment, user's contracts on computer software, insurance premium on vehicles, membership dues for professional organizations, subscriptions for professional journals and magazines, professional services, communication-telephone, postage, utilities, advertising, and rental of equipment and land for field plots, and technical assistance in accessing federal funds. Acquisitioning supplies such as fertilizers, pesticides, planting materials, and animal feed as well as research chemicals and instructional materials. Also obtaining equipment and other capital outlay to be used to purchase agriculture-related machinery such as cultivation machines, disc plows, vegetable planters, seed and fertilizers spreaders, chisel plows, insecticide sprayers, tillers, and scientific equipment to support the Experiment Station, office machines and/or furniture for use by researchers, instructors, and extension public service workers.
