OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission operates on general funds provided by the state and special revenue funds generated from admissions, camping and associated charges paid to the park. The staff carefully watches expenses, doing much of the upkeep and routine maintenance in-house.

The Park is requesting in FY 2014 \$18,000 for the purchase of a new pickup to replace the 1997 Sonoma. This was requested and authority given to purchase in FY 2013 but a moratorium was initiated in July of 2012 preventing the authorized purchase. The Park is also requesting authority to purchase a new ATV-type vehicle (mule, 4-wheeler) for maintenance work on the 450 acres.

Grand Gulf Nuclear Plant does not expect any outage work, therefore extra workers/campers, during 2013 and only a very short one in 2014 so the Park will rely on daily visitors and traveling campers for our special funds income.

AGENCY NAME PROGRAM NAME

I. Program Description:

To preserve, maintain, improve, and operate the Historical Monument. With over 400 acres, this park has original fortifications and battle earthenworks and is in an educational experience. The 2 fortifications are the only ones left in their original state in a major Civil War Battlefield in Mississippi. The museum houses thousands of artifacts and is devoted to all aspects of this area's history, from prehistoric to history of the town of Grand Gulf, history of Claiborne County, Civil War, and World Wars I and II. Our visitors tell us this museum is the "best they have seen in the country".

II. Program Objective:

The objectives of this agency are to educate visitors about the facts and the human side of the Civil War, not just dates, places and "old stories handed down", but the actual facts; to maintain and continue to improve the park and to increase efficiency in all aspects of the work; to reach more tourists, both inside and outside the State of Mississippi and abroad, and to attract them to this historical monument, to increase tourism, not only for our agency, but for our county and surrounding areas. Tourism is the key to increased revenues.

- III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 13 Estimated & FY 14 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:
- (C) Non-Recurring Expenses:

Grand Gulf Park will order a new riding lawn mower and a new work truck to replace the 1997 Sonoma.

(D) New ATV:

The Park is requesting \$10,000 out of special funds to purchase a new ATV (mule or 4-wheel type vehicle) for hauling brush, limbs, leaves, etc. These vehicles can go over earth works without tracking up original dirt works important to preserving the Park property.

(E) Soil conservation continua:

There is a large hillside at the upper campground. Erosion is threatening to wash away the hillside, camping pads and road which would substatially cut into our revenue ability. The Park is requesting \$50,000 to finish a project that is being started in early 2013 with 2012 monies.

(F) 2014 Pickup truck for dire:

Grand Gulf Park is requesting authority to spend \$18,000 for the purchase of a new pickup truck. The oldest park truck, a 1997Sonoma, is in terrible condition and needs to be replaced. The Park requested and received permission to buy a new one in 2013 HOWEVER then Senate Bill 2917 put a freeze on the purchase of new vehicles.

(G) Salary increases:

The Park is requesting salary increases for all employees. The Park has four employees making less than \$9.00 an hour. That is hard to live on. The Commissioners are requesting an increase in salary funds to bring these employees to a reasonable amount per hour and also to give at least cost of living raises to the other four employees.

1 The Grand Gulf Military Park routinely receives high praise from day visitors and campers. Because of our good reputation, we have repeat visitors and those who come by word of mouth recommendations. Our brochures are placed at all of the state welcome centers and several chamber of commerce offices. Some of our visitors and campers take brochures to pass to others. The park has a well-maintained website. A facebook fan page has been set up to promote park projects and groups. Letters and brochures have been sent to surrounding area schools and churches encouraging them to come for day-outings. Articles and pictures have been featured in area newspapers and magazines which is great free advertisement. We are seeing an increased number of day visitors due to the 5 year period of the Civil War Sesquicentennial.

Grand Gulf Park reopened in July after the 2011 flood closing of two months. Long term campers returned and by November of 2011 the 42 RV and 6 tent sites were full in preparation for the outage at the nuclear plant which began in February, 2012. In addition to the Park site, we maintain three associated properties which draw visitors that may not actually visit the park proper: the Mississippi River Road, Fort Cobun and Point Lookout. This staff is well informed about our facilities as well as the surrounding area.

1 Grand Gulf Park operates on General Funds spent primarily for salaries and special fund revenues from campers and visitors. This was the best year ever for special fund income. The Park experienced good visitors and campers in 2012 due to the outage at Grand Gulf Nuclear. Although we wont keep the overnight campers that we did in 2012, the Park anticipates an increase in day visitors due to the sesquicentennial of the Civil War. Port Gibson is a part of General Grant's Vicksburg campaign and much publicity has been made thus far drawing visitors this way.

NARRATIVE 2014 BUDGET REQUEST

GRAND GULF MILITARY MONUMENT COMMISSION

Name of Agency

The Commissioners and Staff of Grand Gulf Military Monument Park appreciate the continued support of the Legislature in approving our lump sum budget for 2013. We have tried and succeeded to cooperate with the state at every level. We continue to spend only what is necessary to maintain the buildings and grounds for the benefit of our campers and customers. Much of the day to day routine maintenance, labor and repairs are done by park personnel. The Park is located just one-half mile from the Mississippi River.

There is a hillside at the upper campground that has been designated for work by the Soil Conservation Service but the federal government has not come through with the money to do the project. It was the decision of the Commissioners, after consulting with our budget analyst, that we should make plans to begin stabilization of the hillside and the road which runs around the outer edge of the upper campground. The erosion has exposed and compromised the sewage system. If this is not fixed soon we run the risk of loosing the pads, road and sewage and ultimately camping income. Work began with FY 2012 monies as a necessity but we are requesting \$50,000 in general funds to continue this project in 2014.

Grand Gulf Park had 7 full time and 1 part-time PINS allotted in FY 2012 and FY 2013 and are requesting the same for FY 2014. The Park is requesting money for salary increases. There are four hardworking employees making less than \$9.00 an hour and the Commissioners would like to see them raised to a reasonable rate. In addition, three of the other employees have not had even cost of living raises in over four years.

The Executive Director and Commissioners are frugal with the money allowed in the annual budget spending only what is absolutely necessary. The staff does not have cell phones and routinely does maintenance and repairs on our four vehicles, four lawnmowers, the utility vehicle, 13 buildings and 400 acres.

The years 2013 and 2014 mark the sesquicentennial of the Civil War. Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission is a Civil War Battlefield Monument. We are anticipating an increase in day visitors for this occasion.

Rand-McNally annually scours the country for "outstanding trips and stops, representing the best America has to offer". Grand Gulf Military Monument Park is listed as a "great stop" in their Following the Old Man River tour, one of only five trips recommended this year. The editors develop trips by choosing spots with "special character which capture the region's essence and appeal to a broad range of people." The museum is looking better than ever after flood renovations and ready to greet visitors from around the country as they have found us either through sesquicentennial tours or Rand-McNally recommendations.

In planning for the 2013 budget, Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission is submitting a budget of \$427,875. \$50,000 of that is in general funds for continued work on the grounds of the upper campground. If we loose this hillside it will inclue camping pads and therefore income. The Park is requesting \$18,000 for the purchase of a new mid-size pickup truck to replace the 1997 GMC Sonoma and \$10,000 for the purchase of a new ATV-type work piece of equipment, both to be purchased out of special funds.

The Commissioners of Grand Gulf Military Monument Park request approval of a lump sum budget in the amount of \$427,875 with the flexibility to adjust within our own budget to meet unforseen circumstances.
