Name of Agency

The Veterans Affairs Board insures that this state's more than 212,508,000 veterans, eligible dependents, survivors and present members of the Armed forces of the United States receives maximum federal, state, and local benefits to which they are entitled (through our Claims Division); We approve, and supervise the schools, institutions, and establishments in Mississippi providing training to persons receiving (or eligible to receive) monetary benefits from the Department of Veterans Affairs of more than 6,500 enrolled veterans (through our State Approving Agency):

The Nursing Home Division oversees the operation of four (4) veteran's homes providing an average of 210,240 days of nursing care.

The Cemetery Division conducts interments for eligible veterans, spouse and dependents.

The majority of State Veterans Affairs funds are received on reimbursable bases and we must keep adequate cash on hand. The past history validates that we keep from 2 to 2.5 million on hand to facilitate expenditures and to account for federal reimbursements.

The agency has programmed money for projected construction and maintenance cost. We must continue to monitor those cost and reprogram and defer items should the need arise.

We realize that bond money may not be available for capital expenditures and improvement; therefore we have adjusted our budget accordingly.

We project an increase in salaries. Specifically, the salaries increase is to facilitate the agency's anticipated request to allow spending authority to increase wages in specified specialties and job descriptions. Without some increases the agency's ability to deliver continued high level of nursing care and other services could be in jeopardy.

The increase in the salaries category will not result in an increase in General Funds.

This budget request is needed to provide quality care, service and assistance to our veterans, dependents and surviving spouse.
