#### NARRATIVE 2014 BUDGET REQUEST

The Board of Registration for Foresters operates under Section 73-36-37 Foresters Registration Law of 1977 of the Mississippi Code. Any person that practices forestry means any professional forestry service including but not limited to consultation, investigation, evaluation, valuation, planning, recommending sivicultural or harvesting practices or responsible supervision of any forestry activities in connection with any public or private lands wherein the public welfare and property are concerned or involved when such professional services require the application of forestry principles, knowledge and data.

The Board is supported totally by funds generated from registration fees, renewal fees and fines.

The overall objective of this program is to assure that Mississippians who need the services of a forester can be assured that a Registered Forester in the State of Mississippi has received a proper education and received continuing education annually to meet the requirements established by law.

There have been 2525 persons registered by the Board since it began in 1977. Apporximately 1200 are currently in good standing with continuting education requirements met and fees paid. We are striving to get the licensure numbers up with more public awareness. In FY 2001 a web site was designed and implemented, www.cfr.msstate.edu/borf. The web site is updated weekly with information on Registered Foresters in good standing indicating the foresters that work for a fee and the Mississippi counties where their business is located. Other information includes: Registered Forester Law, Policies and Procedures of the Board, Education Requirements, and necessary forms for Application, Renewals, Examination and Complaints. Also includes a list of Board Members, Code of Ethics and a map to show the location of the Board office. In 2008 a newsletter was available and the web site was completely updated. In 2009 a hanbook with updated laws, Code of Ethics, and Policies of the Board was printed and mailed to all active Foresters.

An increased effort will be made to give the public more information reagarding the reasons for being a Registered Forester and the advantages of using a Registered Forester for forestry-related work. Effects will be increased to stop persons that are practicing forestry without a license in the State of Mississippi. A contract with the Attorney General's office will be put in place to help process complaints.

The Board of Registration for Foresters is looking to relocate its office to be centrally located in the Capital Complex and to enhance its daily operations to accommodate the public and to promote awareness. A business consultant will be put in place to streamline daily operations and increase licensure efforts for the Board until an official employee can be hired by the Board. The office is currently operated by a contract worker and its Board Members.
