Miscellaneous collections may include data base charges generated by the Administrative Office of Courts, prior year refunds, etc. This fund is also used for special fund expenses incurred by the Supreme Court, Supreme Court Clerk, and the State Library.

Treasury Fund #3065 was established in FY2011 to receive fees collected by the circuit clerks for each petition to expunge an offense under Section 19-19-71. The fund, administered by the Administrative Office of Courts, shall be used for the operation of the judicial system as determined necessary by the Supreme Court.

In FY 2012, HB1490 appropriated \$1,255,784 from the Drug Court Special Fund to offset the normal operating expenditures of the Supreme Court.

#### I. Program Description:

The Supreme Court is the highest court and the court of last resort within the State of Mississippi. It is composed of nine (9) elected justices who serve eight-year staggered terms to provide continuity. The Supreme Court render decisions on cases appealed from two (2) courts of general jurisdiction within Mississippi; the Chancery and Circuit Courts under limited circumstances as well as direct appeals from county courts.

In addition to appellate jurisdiction, the Supreme Court has the power to issue extraordinary writs. The nine justices may sit en banc (all members participating) or in three-judge panels. Cases reserved exculsively for the Supreme Court are death penalty cases, appeals involving utility rates, annexations, bond issues, election contests, and statutes held unconstitutional by a lower court; cases involving attorney discipline and judicial performance; certified questions from a federal court; cases involving a major question of first impression; fundamental and urgent issues of broad public importance requiring prompt determination; substantial constitutional questions concerning the validity of a statute, ordinance, court rule, or administrative rule or regulation; and issues where there is an inconsistency or conflict in court decisions. The Supreme Court has the authority to assign appeals to the Court of Appeals.

#### II. Program Objective:

The overall objective of this program is the efficient and timely disposition of all matters brought before the Court and provide administrative leadership and support services to all courts statewide.

- (C) Non-Recurring Expenses:

We were appropriated \$167,200 in FY2014 for new desktops and printers. We are only requesting \$28,500 for FY2015 to cover the costs in purchasing (4) new Enterasys switches, (1) file server, and (1) file server rack.

#### (D) Salaries:

An increase of \$175,654 or 3.40% is requested for FY2015. The Judiciary is also requesting the addition of 1 (one) PIN in FY2015.

The majority of this increase, \$107,262 or 61.06% is requested as special fund spending authority to allow for the increase associated with the judicial compensation plan created by HB484 passed during the 2012 Legislative Session.

The additional \$68,392 is requested in general funds for the following:

\$14,550: To fund the incremental steps for staff attorneys, law clerks and judicial assistants in accordance with guidelines established by the Judiciary base upon years of admittance to the Bar and tenure with the Judiciary

\$53,842: To establish a new position within the Judiciary for a new Deputy Marshal at the rate of \$40,000 plus fringe.

### (E) Dec in Special Funds Avail:

For FY2014, the Supreme Court's appropriation included special fund spending authority in the amount of \$500,247 for the Supreme Court; which consists of \$339,308 from the Supreme Court Special Funds; and \$160,939 from the Judicial Operations Fund.

This use of this \$339,308 in special funds will exhaust the cash reserves currently in the fund. The fees charged by the Clerk's Office and Library generate an average of \$200,000 in revenues each year which will be available in FY2015, therefore we are requesting that \$139,308 of the FY2014 special fund appropriation be replaced with general funds in FY2015.

The budget for the Supreme Court consists of three programs-Supreme Court Services, Supreme Court Clerk's Office and the State Library.

A total of \$7,114,819 is requested for the Supreme Court for FY2015. This is an increase of \$26,454 or 0.37% above the FY2014 appropriation. Following is a detailed recap of this request.

A total of \$5,345,159 is requested in this category, which is an increase of \$175,654 or 3.40% above the FY2014 appropriation. The Judiciary is also requesting the addition of 1 (one) PIN in FY2015.

The majority of this increase, \$107,262 or 61.06% is requested as special fund spending authority to allow for the increase associated with the judicial compensation plan created by HB484 passed during the 2012 Legislative Session.

The additional \$68,392 is requested in general funds for the following:

\$14,550: To fund the incremental steps for staff attorneys, law clerks and judicial assistants in accordance with guidelines established by the Judiciary base upon years of admittance to the Bar and tenure with the Judiciary

\$53,842: To establish a new position within the Judiciary for a new Deputy Marshal at the rate of \$40,000 plus fringe.

#### Personal Services - Travel

\$342,500 is requested in the travel category. In-state travel is requested at \$327,500 for expense allowances and mileage for the justices and for additional expenses to allow the justices and support staff to attend various in-state meetings/conferences. MS Code Section 25-3-43 allows the justices to receive an expense allowance, in lieu of travel reimbursements, based on the expense rate allowed federal government employees in Jackson. A rate of \$123.00 per day was used for projecting these costs and was applied to the 240 maximum days per judge per year, while attending to judicial duties in Jackson. These earnings are subject to employer match on social security and on retirement (if employed on or before December 31, 2003). \$15,000 is requested for out-of-state travel to allow the justices to attend various judicial training classes, appellate judge seminars, and conferences. No increase is requested above the FY2014 appropriation.

#### Contractual Services

A total of \$1,020,783 is requested for this category. No increase is requested above the FY2014 appropriation for contractual services.

#### A. Tuition, Rewards and Awards: \$2,200

\$2,200 is requested for employee training for registration fees for various appellate conferences/seminars and the annual meeting of the Mississippi Bar Association and tuition associated with judicial training classes. There are scholarships available through the National Judicial College to fund a portion of this tuition which was considered in this request.

#### B. Communications, Transportation and Utilities: \$30,800

\$26,900 is for postage associated with mailing monthly invoices and statements and also for the rent on the post office boxes. \$3,900 is in freight for the shipment of court certificates, supplies to the Court and books received by the Library,

#### C. Rents: \$748,496

\$717,996 is requested for rent of the Gartin Justice Building, per our lease agreement with the Department of Finance and Administration. \$30,500 is for the rental of a copiers and fax machines utilized throughout the office.

#### D. Fees, Professional & Other Services: \$86,877

\$2,200 is requested for SAAS fees associated with the processing of receipts, warrants, payment vouchers and purchase orders: \$5,665 for MMRS Revolving Fund Fees: \$2,500 for Department of Audit fees; \$2,412 for State Personnel Board fees: \$71,300 for security services provided by Capitol Police; and \$2,800 for contractual employees (including fringe).

#### E. Other Contractual Services: \$25,350

\$4,300 is requested for the annual assessment by the Tort Claims Board; \$13,900 for the justice's professional liability insurance and employee bonds; and \$7,150 for dues including the Mississippi Bar Association, Mississippi Bar Foundation, American Bar Association, Magnolia Bar Association, and the National Bar Association.

#### F. Information Technology:\$127,060

\$2,470 is requested for IS professional fees; \$17,000 for service charges to the State Data Center; \$33,275 for annual software maintenance and acquisitions; \$57,200 for monthly phone service and maintenance charges from ITS; \$15,315 for public network access, such as Lexis-Nexis; and \$1,800 for pager and satellite phone usage.

## Commodities

A total of \$377,877 is requested in this category for FY2015. No increase is requested above the FY2014 appropriation in commodities.

### A. Printing and Office Supplies and Materials: \$369,377

This consist of \$9,600 for printing and binding; \$20,500 for duplication and reproduction supplies; \$14,700 for routine office supplies and machines; \$8,200 for paper and miscellaneous office supplies; and \$316,377 to maintain the collections within the State Library.

#### B. Equipment Repair Parts, Supplies and Accessories: \$300

\$300 is request for fuel for the van maintained by the Judiciary.

## C. Other Supplies and Materials: \$8,200

This consist of \$1,700 for food for business meetings; \$3,500 for equipment repair parts; and \$3,000 for other supplies and materials.

## Equipment

\$28,500 is requested in for equipment, which is a decrease of \$149,200 or 83.96% from the 2014 appropriation for this category. This one-time request for general funds will provide the following: three (3) Enterasys C5 Network Switches for the Gartin Justice Building at \$5,000 each or \$15,000; one (1) process server to combine the multiple servers within the Court at \$15,000 which will be shared with the Court of Appeals at a cost of \$7,500 each; one (1) server rack at \$2,000 to be shared with the Court of Appeals at a cost of \$1,000 each and \$5,000 for miscellaneous equipment repairs required throughout the year.

#### Overall\Funding:

The Supreme Court budget is funded from general funds and from fees charged by the Supreme Court Clerk's Office and State Library.

For FY2014, the Supreme Court's appropriation included special fund spending authority in the amount of \$500,247 for the Supreme Court; which consists of \$339,308 from the Supreme Court Special Funds; and \$160,939 from the Judicial Operations Fund.

This use of this \$339,308 in special funds will exhaust the cash reserves currently in the fund. The fees charged by the Clerk's Office and Library generate an average of \$200,000 in revenues each year which will be available in FY2015, therefore we are requesting that \$139,308 of the FY2014 special fund appropriation be replaced with general funds in FY2015.

In conclusion, we are requesting that the Supreme Court be funded with \$6,646,618 of general funds and \$468,201 of special fund spending authority for a total appropriation of \$7,114,819 for FY2015.?
