I. Program Description:

Mississippi's trial court system consists of two general jurisdiction courts (circuit and chancery) and three (3) limited jurisdiction courts (county, juvenile, and municipal). Twenty (20) chancery courts have jurisdiction over matters involving equity, divorce, alimony, probate, guardianship, and sanity. Chancery courts have exclusive jurisdiction over juvenile matters where there are no county courts. Their jurisdiction over equity matters involving less than \$200,000 is concurrent with county courts. Most chancery court cases are non-jury proceedings, although juries may be impaneled in certain circumstances. Twenty-two (22) circuit courts have original jurisdiction over all civil and criminal matters not vested exclusively in another court. Most circuit court cases are heard by juries, although some circumstances may permit bench trials. Circuit judges also have the power to issue extraordinary writs.

II. Program Objective:

The objective of this program is the direct support of the constitutionally mandated duties of the trial judges of this state and related personnel. In Fiscal Year 1992, The Department of Finance & Administration transferred the administrative duties and management of funds to the Supreme Court. Such transfer enlarges the program objective to include statewide fiscal management of the salary and support features included in this funding.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 14 Estimated & FY 15 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) Salaries:

The increase of \$953,496 is requested in special fund spending authority to allow for the increase associated with the judicial compensation plan created by HB484 passed during the 2012 Legislative Session.

(E) Equipment:

\$71,400 is requested to allow for the purchase of 51 desktops at \$1,400.00 each. These desktops are needed to replace outdated desktops being utilized by Chancery and Circuit Judges throughout the State, some of which are no longer supported by Windows.

(F) Dec in Special Funds Avail:

For FY2014, the Trail Judges' appropriation included special fund spending authority in the amount of \$2,679,120; which consists of \$1,447,074 from the Judicial Operations Fund; \$400,000 from the Criminal Justice Fund and \$832,046 to be taken from the reserve cash balance in the Trial Judges' special fund which received transfers from the Drug Courts and Budget Contingency Funds in prior years. The use of the \$832,046 in FY2014 will exhaust the remaining cash reserves in this fund, therefore, we are requesting that this amount be replaced with general funds in FY2015.

Mississippi's trial court system consists of two general jurisdiction courts (circuit and chancery) and three (3) limited jurisdiction courts (county, juvenile, and municipal). Twenty (20) chancery courts have jurisdiction over matters involving equity, divorce, alimony, probate, guardianship, and sanity. Chancery courts have exclusive jurisdiction over juvenile matters where there are no county courts. Their jurisdiction over equity matters involving less than \$200,000 is concurrent with county courts. Most chancery court cases are non-jury proceedings, although juries may be impaneled in certain circumstances. Twenty-two (22) circuit courts have original jurisdiction over all civil and criminal matters not vested exclusively in another court. Most circuit court cases are heard by juries, although some circumstances may permit bench trials. Circuit judges also have the power to issue extraordinary writs.

\$26,507,309 is requested for the FY2015 budget. This is an increase of \$1,024,896 or 4.02% above the FY2014 appropriation. A summary of this request is as follows:

Personal Services - Salaries

A total of \$24,406,702 is requested in this category which is an increase of \$953,496 or 4.06% above the FY2014 appropriation. The overall request includes funding for one-hundred two (102) trial judge salaries, senior status and special judge appointments, Compliant Tribunal per diem, special judge appointments and an annual support staff allowance of \$80,000 per judge. Trial judge salaries are set by statute.

The increase of \$953,496 is requested in special fund spending authority to allow for the increase associated with the judicial compensation plan created by HB484 passed during the 2012 Legislative Session.

Personal Services - Travel

\$919,207 is requested in this category. No increase is requested for FY2015.

\$794,207 is requested for in-state travel to allow judges to travel to court in business throughout their district, to include meals, mileage, and lodging.

\$125,000 is requested in out-of-state travel to allow the trial judges the ability to attend classes and seminars sponsored by the National Judicial College, American Academy of Judicial Education, Mississippi Bar Association, American Bar Association, Fifth Circuit Federal Court District, Mississippi/Louisiana/Arkansas judicial branches, etc.

Contractual Services

\$84,000 is requested in this category. No increase is requested for FY2015.

\$32,498 is requested for SAAS and MMRS fees. \$15,500 is requested to cover the trial Judge portion of the Tort Claims Assessment in FY2015.

\$36,002 is requested for the Lexis-Nexis contract for on-line legal research. This subscriber agreement allows judges, staff attorneys, and law clerks to access Lexis-Nexis and CD-ROM libraries for legal research purposes. These on-line research charges are shared with the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, and AOC.

Commodities

\$1,026,000 is requested in the commodity category for trial judge office operating and office space allowances. The office allowance is set by statute at \$9,000 per trial judge and the rent allowance is set my statute at \$4,000 annually per judge. (Trial judges are allowed an office space allowance if no county space is provided to them; there

are an estimated 27 judges eligible for the office space allowance).

Equipment

\$71,400 is requested to allow for the purchase of 51 desktops at \$1,400.00 each. These desktops are needed to replace outdated desktops being utilized by Chancery and Circuit Judges throughout the State, some of which are no longer supported by Windows.

Overall\Funding:

The Trial Judge budget is funded from general funds and transfers from the Criminal Justice Fund maintained by the Department of Finance and Administration and from the Judicial Operations Fund maintained by the Administrative Office of Courts.

For FY2014, the Trail Judges' appropriation included special fund spending authority in the amount of \$2,679,120; which consists of \$1,447,074 from the Judicial Operations Fund; \$400,000 from the Criminal Justice Fund and \$832,046 to be taken from the reserve cash balance in the Trial Judges' special fund which received transfers from the Drug Courts and Budget Contingency Funds in prior years.

The use of the \$832,046 in FY2014 will exhaust the remaining cash reserves in this fund, therefore, we are requesting that this amount be replaced with general funds in FY2015.

In conclusion, we are requesting that the Trial Judges be funded with \$23,706,739 of general funds and \$2,800,570 of special fund spending authority for a total appropriation of \$26,507,309 in FY2015.
