The jurisdiction of the COA is limited to those matters which have been assigned by the Supreme Court.

The majority of this increase, \$116,730 or 60.27% is requested as special fund spending authority to allow for the increase associated with the judicial compensation plan created by HB484 passed during the 2012 Legislative Session.

The additional \$76,942 is requested in general funds for the following:

\$23,100: To fund the incremental steps for staff attorneys, law clerks and judicial assistants in accordance with guidelines established by the Judiciary base upon years of admittance to the Bar and tenure with the Judiciary

\$53,842: To establish a new position within the Judiciary for a new Deputy Marshal at the rate of \$40,000 plus fringe.

(E) Equipment:

We are requesting \$23,500 in equipment to purchase (3) Enterasys switches, \$7,500 for a process server and \$1,000 for a server rack. This is to replace antiquated equipment used to operate the internet/intranet of the Court.

II. Program Objective:

The primary objective of the Supreme Court Clerk's Office is to administer a timely and efficient cas flow management system for all case filings received by the Supreme Court and Court of Appeals. The Supreme Court determines which cases will be assigned to the Court of Appeals. Each case appealed to the Supreme Court is processed twice in the Clerk's Office. Upon receipt of the Notice of Appeal, tracking of the record preparation and the timely filing of briefs begins. When the decision is rendered, the case is returned to the Clerk's Office for dissemination of the opinion, issuance of the mandate, and preparation of the record for storage. This office must calendar all filings promptly and determine compliance with the rules of the Court, including any jurisdictional requirements and framework. The progess of appeals, motions, and discretionary review matters are tracked statewide on a daily basis. Funding for this program is reflected under the Supreme Court Administrative Office.

For FY 2015, a total of \$ 6,035,330 is requested for the Court of Appeals. This is an increase of \$217,172 or 3.73% above the FY2014 appropriation. A summary of this request is as follows:

Personal Services - Salaries

A total of \$4,880,030 is requested in this category, which is an increase of \$193,672 or 4.13% above the FY2014 appropriation. The Judiciary is also requesting the addition of 1 (one) PIN in FY2015.

The majority of this increase, \$116,730 or 60.27% is requested as special fund spending authority to allow for the increase associated with the judicial compensation plan created by HB484 passed during the 2012 Legislative Session.

The additional \$76,942 is requested in general funds for the following:

\$23,100: To fund the incremental steps for staff attorneys, law clerks and judicial assistants in accordance with guidelines established by the Judiciary base upon years of admittance to the Bar and tenure with the Judiciary

\$53,842: To establish a new position within the Judiciary for a new Deputy Marshal at the rate of \$40,000 plus fringe.

Personal Services - Travel

\$363,400 is requested in the travel category. In-state travel is requested at \$348,400 for expense allowances and mileage for judges and for additional expenses to allow judges and support staff to attend various in-state meetings/conferences. MS Code Section 25-3-43 allows judges to receive an expense allowance, in lieu of travel reimbursements, based on the expense rate allowed federal government employees in Jackson. A rate of \$123.00 per day was used for projecting these costs and was applied to the 240 maximum days per judge per year, while attending to judicial duties in Jackson. These earnings are subject to employer match on social security and on retirement (if employed on or before December 31, 2003). \$15,000 is requested for out-of-state travel to allow judges to attend various judicial training classes, appellate judge seminars, and conferences. No increase is requested in this category for FY2015.

Contractual Services

A total of \$748,900 is requested in this category. No increase is requested in this area.

A. Tuition, Rewards, and Awards: \$3,500

\$3,500 is requested for employee training for registration fees for various appellate conferences/seminars and the annual meeting of the Mississippi Bar Association and tuition associated with judicial training classes. There are scholarships available through the National Judicial College to fund a portion of this tuition which was considered in this request. For the FY2012 appropriation, Court of Appeals was underfunded in this category.

B Communications, Transportation, and Utilities; \$800

\$500 is requested for postage; \$300 is requested for freight. Postage charges are requested for mailing court opinions to law schools; correspondence to attorneys, trial judges and court reporters regarding

supplementation of records; personnel correspondence; etc. Freight charges are for the delivery of various books needed for the Court's library of legal reference materials and for shipping computer components. There is no increase requested in this area.

C. Rents: \$603,528

\$596,028 is requested for office rent in the Gartin building, per our lease agreement with the Department of Finance and Administration; and \$7,500 for the rental of copiers and fax machines utilized throughout the office.

D. Fees, Professional, and Other Services: \$78,162

\$500 is requested for support costs to Finance and Administration for SAAS accounting system charges associated with processing receipts, warrants, payment vouchers and purchase orders; \$4,100 for MMRS Revolving Fund Fees; \$2,052 for State Personnel Board fees; \$64,000 for fees to the Department of Finance and Administration for security services at the Gartin Building; \$7,400 for repairs and service of miscellaneous office equipment and \$110 for renewal of Notaries.

E. Other Contractual Services: \$33,810

\$3,500 is requested for the annual tort claim assessment, \$17,100 for the judge's professional liability insurance policies and \$5,700 for dues including judges' memberships to the Mississippi Bar Association, Mississippi Bar Foundation, American Bar Association, Magnolia Bar Association, National Bar Association, and Council of Chief Judges of State Court of Appeals.

F. Information Technology: \$36,610

\$110 is requested for ITS professional services. \$6,400 is requested for payments to the state computer center for Capitol Complex network charges, ADABASE usage, disk storage, batch processing, CICS usage and state-wide backbone costs. \$1,300 is requested for annual maintenance and purchase of new software for the Court of Appeals. \$18,100 is requested for monthly phone service and maintenance charges from ITS; and \$10,700 for public network access, such as Lexis-Nexis.

Commodities

\$19,500 is requested in this category, which is no increase above the FY2014 appropriation.

A. Printing and Office Supplies and Materials: \$18,800

\$2,400 is requested for printed materials to include envelopes, stationery, the annual report and various other reports; \$10,000 for reproduction supplies (primarily toner for copiers and laser printers); \$2,400 for routine office supplies; \$2,400 for paper supplies for copy machines, laser printers, etc.; and \$1,600 for library books for use as legal references by judges and their staff.

B. Other Supplies and Material: \$700

\$700 if requested for other supplies and materials.

Equipment

\$23,500 is requested in IT equipment.

This one-time request for general funds will provide the following: two (2) Enterasys C5 Network Switches for the Gartin Justice Building at \$5,000 each or \$10,000; one (1) process server to combine the multiple servers within the Court at \$15,000 which will be shared with the Supreme Court at a cost of \$7,500 each; one (1) server rack at \$2,000 to be shared with the Supreme Court at a cost of \$1,000 each and \$5,000 for miscellaneous equipment repairs required throughout the year.

Subsidies, Loans and Grants

To allow funding for critical needs in the salary and contractual services categories, no funds are requested in the subsidies category.

Funding

For FY2015, we are requesting that the Court of Appeals be funded with \$5,746,669 of general funds and \$288,661 of special fund spending authority as a transfer from the Judicial Operations Fund for a total appropriation of \$6,035,330.
