Mississippi Alcohol Safety Education Program

Budget Request, FY2015

This budget request represents the estimated costs of operation for the Mississippi Alcohol Safety Education Program (MASEP) for FY 2015. This FY 2015 request is increased by 2% from FY 2014 funding. Each budget category was examined carefully in an effort to realize maximum program efficiency. Some adjuistments, however, were made within categories in order to continue program activities at a maximum level of performance.

Approval of this budget will allow MASEP to continue to function as a mandated element of the DUI control system in Mississippi.

- A. Personnel Services
 - 1. Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits

MASEP is requesting \$1,192,425 in its personnel category. This is a 2.55% increase (\$29,708) from FY 2014, and necessary to meet the staffing demands for the program.

B. Travel

An increase of 15.73% (\$14,000) from FY 2014 is requested for travel due to increasing costs of fuel and hotel accommodations.

C. Contractual Services

The increase for this category is 3.44% (\$3,450) is requested in this category based on FY 2014 figures.

D. Commodities

An increase of 30.13% (\$22,000) is requested in this category primarily due to the use of the Procard and items being coded as a commodity rather than equipment.

E. Capital Outlay

The decrease of (-)5.30% (-\$1,400) is also due the use of the Procard and more items being coded as a commodity rather than equipment.

F. Subsidies, Loans & Grants

A decrease in this category of (-)29.51% (-\$10,050) is anticipated due to less contract match in the future.

The MASEP FY 2015 is requesting an overall increase of 2% (\$29,708) which has been allocated in Personnel in order to meet rising personnel costs for PERS increases, enrollment increases and to prevent further decline in competitive salaries, funds are requested for personnel cost adjustments to maitain competitive salary and benefits.
