FEDERAL FUNDS

All federal grant funds are sought by the individual departments of the College. The College hired a grant writer to assist the departments with this process in FY2010. These funds play a major role in the services that are provided to our students. As a result of Title III funds, the college has just begun renovations of two buildings on the Utica campus to allow for more room in the bookstore and an updated look to the student union facility. Prior to these projects, one or our buildings was renovated to provide a health and wellness facility for the students, employees and community to improve their health in rural Hinds County. It has also provided a great space for teaching and meetings.

The federal college work study program provides funds for many of our students, who might not be able to attend college. This program has become more important to our college with the recent reductions to Pell eligibility.

Our special services grant provides counseling and tutoring to the high school students on weekends and during the summer. In these sessions, the students are introduced to the college environment and are made aware of many programs available to these students.

The M2M grant and the HIT Technology grants that we have received in the last two years have provided the college with the opportunity to reach a new group of students and allowed us to pursue different programs for the students in our district.

STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

The appropriations of special funds for the community colleges are very important to many programs. They have helped the college develop new programs and offer services to the general public that would not have been feasible.

We are really excited about the new capital expense funds. Our buildings and improvements are in real need and we have not had the funds to take care of many deferred maintenance projects. In FY14, we have plans to repairs at least 3 roofs that have leaks and would have slowly deteriorated. This money will be a great investment to keep our buildings for many more years.

OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

The appropriations of special funds for the community colleges are very important to many programs. They have helped the college develop new programs and offer services to the general public that would not have been feasible. Our workforce development center and our sign language interpreter programs would not be possible without these funds. The special funds are needed and should be expanded to provide opportunities in other areas. For example, our college sees a real need in adult education opportunities and dual enrollment/dual credit courses.
