The rate is projected to increase for FY2015 to 73.10%, up from the FY2014 rate of 73.05% for the Federal fiscal year. However, the blended rate (based on the state fiscal year) decreased from FY14 to FY15.

(E) Part A, B, and D-Medicare:

These expenses are driven by the number of dually eligible participants and the premium rates charged by CMS. The Division of Medicaid pays premiums so that providers bill Medicare as primary payer for eligible services. Overall, Part A,B and D (Clawback) are expected to increase.

(F) Replace Kidney Dialysis:

These funds were originally appropriated in FY 2009 specified for nonemergency transportation services, and remain unspent. This money is in Fund 3322, and DOM received authority to spend these funds in FY2014.

(G) Replace B C F:

The BCF is one-time money appropriated by the legislature. We may not receive this funding in FY15. We will need it replaced with general funds.

(H) A C A Mandates:

The Division of Medicaid is expecting an increase in medical services expenditures due to mandatory ACA requirements. This includes the potential additional enrollment due to the woodwork effect population and the foster children expansion to age 26, and health issurer fee. Our request is lower than the 2012 Milliman report estimate because the ACA mandate penality was extended from January 1st 2014 to January 1st 2015.

(I) Program Growth:

Medicaid estimates growth in payments for medical services over FY14 projected levels. This growth is primarily due to an increase in service utilization, provider payment levels in managed care expansion.

(J) Provider Incentive Payment:

The incentive payments are required by ARRA legislation and are 100% federally funded payments to hospitals and physicians for electronic health record systems. They are expected to vary overall from year to year. Payments in FY15 are expected to be lower than FY14 payments.
