2015 BUDGET REQUEST

PERS is requesting a total of \$8,400,000 in 2015 to fund our technology system upgrade. We are committed to pursuing the most economical avenues for adequate technological support of pension benefit administration. PERS' current programming language, Forte, is no longer a supported development platform. Enhancements to the Forte language, security patches, and operating system are no longer available. In addition, the current programming and technical architecture does not support web-enabled functionality and is very difficult to integrate with third-party software and newer operating systems. PERS must continue to address the demand of our customers, as well as changes in technology, to effectively support the processing of pension benefits.

To date, PERS has engaged L.R. Wechsler, LTD., a technology consulting firm that specializes in project management and oversight of pension fund technology solutions. CedarCrestone Inc. is the implementor of the new pension administration solution. CedarCrestone is moving its public-sector business to a sister organization, Sierra Systems. However, the same staff resources remain on the PERS project. Sierra Systems and PERS are nearing the user-acceptance testing phase of a three-year project, with an estimated implementation date of the first quarter of 2014. PERS budget year 2015 request is for a total of \$8,400,000 for contractual services. Completion of the entire project is scheduled for fiscal year 2015.
