### FEDERAL FUNDS

The MCL receives federal grant funding specifically for improvement of the MCL.

### OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

Fund 3713 is supported by fees assigned to agencies for forensic analysis. The MCL charges a \$50 fee for each case received by the lab. The MCL is also authorized to receive a \$300 assessment to a felon who has plead guilty or been found guilty.

Fund 371N received an assessment of \$100 for individual that enters into the Department of Corrections for the collection, processing and analysis of a DNA sample to be uploaded in the DNA database. This fund helps defer the cost of DNA analysis.

Fund 371E is a \$25 assessment collected on each DUI conviction and is used to support the blood and breath implied consent DUI program in the state.

Forensic Analysis is the primary service provided by the MCL. This program consists of eight highly technical and specialized areas of expertise: Trace/Microanalysis, Impression Evidence, Firearms and Toolmarks, Toxicology, Identification of Controlled Substances, Human Impairment DUI Testing, Physical Evidence Analysis, Fire Debris Analysis, and Questioned documents. The scientists in these areas of expertise employ the latest methodology on state of the art technology to develop information from items of evidence from criminal activity. They prepare an official report on those scientific findings and provide testimony as an expert witness as required. Training to Law Enforcement Officers is also provided on proper evidence collection techniques. The quality of scientific analyses performed in this program is evaluated and accredited by the American Association of Crime Laboratory Directors-Laboratory Accreditation program.

### II. Program Objective:

The objective of this program is to provide accurate, timely scientific analysis to our clients. The results of those analyses provide the foundation for the criminal justice system to identify, apprehend, and adjuducate individuals responsible for criminal activity.

I. Program Description:

his program was mandated in 1994 by MCA 45-33-15. This statute established a forensic DNA testing laboratory whicj adheres to the federal guidelines established through the Quality Assurance Standards for forensic DNA testing issued by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. This same statute identified the MCL as responsible for the establishment of the sex offender database. This database was expanded by statute in 2003 to include forensic profiles of all known felons. By the end of FY 12 the MCL has uploaded over 70,000 convicted felon profiles. The MCL maintains this database under strict standards and requirements also having access to the national DNA database. This has resulted in solving numerous crimes where the suspect had yet to be identified. This system and the MCL DNA section has dramatically increased the crime-solving capabilites for law enforcement in the state.

### II. Program Objective:

The objective of this program is to utilize a higher degree of scientific descrimination when identifying and individualizing biological stains. This testing allows evidence recovered from crime scenes to be linked to individuals rather than using less descriminating techniques.

The (MCL) Mississippi Crime Laboratory has requested a significant increase in funding for FY 15 due to a number of factors. In early 2014 the MCL anticipates moving from its current 1976 facility to the new 90,000 square foot facility in Rankin County. Significant costs associated with moving scientific equipment, reinstallation, and validation are included. Also the MCL is budgeting for other necessary items not included in the BOB building project funds such as grounds equipment, increase in utilities and contractual services for maintenance, computer and server additions, and scientific equipment. These items are critical in order to be able to move and continue to function.

In addition, federal funding that has supported the states DNA Convicted Offender Database (CODIS) is expected to end this fiscal year. Funding has decreased from \$1.1M, two years ago, to \$464,000. This is a million dollar a year program that interacts with the National DNA database and the 49 other states. The MCL is federally and by state statute responsible for this program. Additional funding is requested to insure continued operation of this program which is essential. The MCL database has already had 100's of DNA hits solving crimes in not only our state, but numerous other states. Further additional funding is requested for the upgrade of DNA technology and instrumentation that will be required for DNA casework. Federal standards which are mandatory will be in place and are planned to be converted by the time the MCL takes possession of the new facility.

The MCL was cut over \$600,000 in general funds for FY 14 which is almost all salary monies. The MCL invests 1 1/2-2 years of training in each analyst prior to them being certified to analyze evidence and testify as an expert witness. The MCL cannot afford to lose any personnel and intends to ask for a deficit appropriation for FY13 if sufficient funds cannot be secured. The MCL is the only full service nationally accredited forensic laboratory in the state and serves of 400 law enforcement agencies. As an accredited laboratory certain standards are required to be met in order to operate to include required continuing education, stringent quality measures, and compliance with FBI guidelines for operation of the State's DNA database and connection to the National DNA database. The MCL has consistently had an increase in examinatins requested of about 14% each year for the past 4 years, however has managed to eliminate the backlog of cases which plagued the laboratory for years.

The budget requested will secure continued operations, allow us to manage the increased case load, and move the main laboratory's operation to the new facility in Rankin County in the Spring of 2014.
