I. Program Description:

To license and regulate contractors doing construction work in the state.

Commercial construction in excess of \$50,000 and Fire Protection systems on private jobs in excess of \$10,000 and public jobs in excess of \$5,000.

Residential builders and remodelers in excess of \$50,000 and \$10,000 respectively.

II. Program Objective:

To protect the health, safety and general welfare of all persons dealing with those who are engaged in the vocation of contracting and to afford such persons an effective and practical protection against incompetent, inexperienced, unlawful and fraudulent acts of contractors.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 14 Estimated & FY 15 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) A1 PERSONAL SERVICES:

The agency is not seeking to change its organizational structure or add new positions. The agency is seeking to award the State Personnel Board's FY14 realignment guidelines. The realignment recommendation was based on salary surveys conducted by or verified by the SPB for similar positions within the state and also for similar functions performed in the surrounding states. The agency is seeking to reallocate one position to conform to SPB guidelines.

The realignment recommendation for the agency requires additional budget authority of only \$95,437 for salaries and fringe benefits. The FY15 request can be supported from revenue generated.

(E) A2 TRAVEL:

The proposed travel budget for FY15 is a small increase above the approved FY14 request, although gasoline prices have drastically increased. Changing the routes of the seven investigators has shown to cut the expenses for fuel, so the costs savings may negate the increasing cost of travel.

(F) E SUBSIDIES, LOANS & GR:

Grants are given to the Mississippi Construction Education Foundation, public high schools and community colleges that participate in the Mississippi Construction Education Foundation's "school-to-work" program, state universities that have construction technology programs, the Mississippi Housing Institute and certain construction educational trusts approved by the Board. Grants are distributed according to number of contractors that renew or apply for licenses. The Board will need \$6,000 to meet these needs.

(G) B CONTRACTUAL:

The agency is requesting a decrease of \$1,036 in this area. The agency anticipates a decrease in contractual expenditures by eliminating some legal services. This cost savings should offset expenses associated with implementing the new statewide accounting system (MAGIC).

(H) C COMMODITIES:

The agency incurred some onetime expenses associated with an enforcement program that will not require additional funding in FY15. Therefore, the agency is requesting a decrease of \$8,600.

(I) E2 EQUIPMENT:

The agency will decrease this category by \$4,000.

The Mississippi Board of Contractors FY15 budget is funded solely from fees the agency collects from the contractors it regulates. The Board's FY15 request is only slightly higher than the appropriation it received in FY14 and this increase can be supported from revenue generated.

A1 SALARIES

The agency is not seeking to change its organizational structure or add new positions. The agency is seeking to award the State Personnel Board's FY14 realignment guidelines. The realignment recommendation was based on salary surveys conducted by or verified by the SPB for similar positions within the state and also for similar functions performed in the surrounding states. The agency is seeking to reallocate one position to conform to State Personnel Board guidelines.

The realignment recommendation for the agency requires additional budget authority of only \$95,437 for salaries and fringe benefits. The FY15 request can be supported from the revenue generated.

A2 TRAVEL

The proposed travel budget for FY15 is a small increase above the approved FY14 request, although gasoline prices have drastically increased. Changing the routes of the seven investigators has shown to cut the expenses for fuel, so the costs savings may negate the increasing cost of travel.

B CONTRACTUAL

The agency is requesting a decrease of \$1,036 in this area. The agency anticipates a decrease in contractual expenditures by eliminating some legal services. This cost savings should offset expenses associated with implementing the new statewide accounting system (MAGIC).

C COMMODITIES

The agency incurred some onetime expenses associated with an enforcement program that will not require additional funding in FY15. Therefore, the agency is requesting a decrease of \$8,600.

E2 EOUIPMENT

The agency will decrease this category by \$4,000.

E SUBSIDIES

Grants are given to the Mississippi Construction Education Foundation, public high schools and community colleges that participate in the Mississippi Construction Education Foundation's "school-to-work" program, state universities that have construction technology programs, the Mississippi Housing Institute and certain construction educational trusts approved by the Board. Grants are distributed according to number of contractors that renew or apply for licenses. The Board will need \$6,000 to meet these needs.
