AGENCY NAME

PROGRAM NAME

I. Program Description:

This program is designed to provide standards, techniques, materials, educational training, and examinations that will assist qualified individuals to prepare for careers as nursing home administrators. This program also involves issuing licenses to qualified individuals and establishing and carrying-out procedures to ensure that licensed individuals are complying with the laws and rules of Mississippi. On-going studies, investigations, and programs are conducted to increase the proficiency of those who care for Mississippi residents in long-term care facilities.

II. Program Objective:

1. Develop and impose standards for licensure

2. Devise and implement educational programs and seminars to assist individuals in preparing for careers in nursing home administration.

- 3. Examine applicants for entry level competency prior to licensing.
- 4. Establish procedures to ensure compliance with standards, laws and rules.
- 5. Regulate and enforce state laws and rules.
- 6. Conduct on-going studies to provide effective programs for conducting competency evaluation.
- 7. Conduct complaint investigations as appropriate.

(D) LICENSURE AND REGULATION:

The Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators is the licensure and regulatory board for Nursing Home Administrators. There are currently 443 licensees in the State of Mississippi. The Board is responsible for training all future Nursing Home Administrators. Training programs must first be approved by the Board. Training occurs for a six-month period by preceptors who also must be approved by the Board and attend training sessions conducted by Board employees. Currently there are 113 certified preceptors and 21 Administrators-in-Training (AIT).

Once the training is complete and a license is issued, the Administrators must obtain continuing education credits to retain their licenses. The tracking of these credits and the monitoring functions associated with licensing and regulation are also the responsibility of the Board's staff.

The tasks associated with the licensing and regulation functions of the agency are performed by one full-time and one part-time position.

The greatest need of the agency is the retention of qualified and experienced staff. The positions of the agency are under-paid for the functions performed. The Board has continually requested that the salary of these positions be commensurate with the responsibilities performed.

To support a pay increase for the Executive Director position, the Board has conducted numerous salary surveys. The salary surveys support our request to increase the salary of this position. The average minimum compensation for Nursing Home Administrative Directors in the surrounding southern states is \$58,958. The average starting salary for other small regulatory boards in Mississippi is approximately \$53,000. We have provided the starting and ending salaries for Mississippi boards and commissions below to further demonstrate the disparity of the salaries of agencies of a similar size performing similar functions. Please note that our position is at the bottom of the list and its ending salary is less than some of the other starting salaries.

The Board recently voted to request that the salary of its Executive Director be raised to \$53,102 and submitted this information to the State Personnel Board for concurrence. We are seeking legislative authority to implement this Board action.

The second position of the Board is part-time in name only as this employee has been authorized by the State Personnel Board to work 39 hours a week. Upon the request of our Board, the State Personnel Board recently completed a review of this support position and they determined that the position was not properly classified. During the course of this review two job classifications were discussed and although the final recommendation was that the position be a Licensing Registration Agent III, we are requesting that the position be a Special Projects Officer IV as the duties and the salary of that classification are closer to the level the Board has determined it wishes to compensate this position. The Board is seeking legislative authority to reallocate this position and have the salary set at \$36,177.

Since the Board generates all its revenues from fees and has the revenue to implement the salary increases, we respectively request that approval be given to implement these personnel actions.

We have provided a summary of the budget by category below.

SALARIES

With the legislative approval to implement the Board actions to increase the salaries of the two agency positions, the total salary line items, including fringe, Board per diems and café and worker's compensation fees would be \$128,366.

TRAVEL

The Board is seeking additional travel authority for FY15 due to need to attend out-of-state conferences to stay abreast of changes in the nursing home industry.

The Board meets on a quarterly basis but from time to time the Board may need to meet more often to take up discipline cases. The Board is asking for the travel to be set at \$3,000 for in-state travel to meet the expenses incurred during these Board meetings and \$2,000 for out-of-state travel for the express purpose of a Board appointee attending one of the two national board meetings.

CONTRACTUAL

The Board currently utilizes 1997 Lotus Suites and Excel spreadsheets as its licensing and compliance database. The information must be entered in both systems to function as required. The use of spreadsheets does not allow for online renewal of licenses, does not enable tracking of education credits online, and a host of other tracking desired by the Board. The Board is in the process of obtaining bids to replace its antiquated system with a database that will eliminate dual entry, will enhance our reporting, and assist the Board in performing daily functions. It is also our desire to have the system eliminate paper files. The Board is seeking to increase its contractual line items to be able to develop and implement the system in two phases, the majority of which is expected to occur in FY15.

The Board is also requesting an increase in contractual expenses due to the fact that the Board has noticed an increase in complaints received. This causes increased expenses due to the fact that the Board's attorney is kept apprised at all times and the Board has to seek legal advice on a regular basis. This legal advice costs the Board more each year.

COMMODITIES

The commodity line items are expected to remain constant with FY14 spending authority with only a \$150 increase to allow for rising costs of office supplies.

Name of Agency

The Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators is the licensure and regulatory board for Nursing Home Administrators. There are currently 443 licensees in the State of Mississippi. The Board is responsible for training all future Nursing Home Administrators. Training programs must first be approved by the Board. Training occurs for a six-month period by preceptors who also must be approved by the Board and attend training sessions conducted by Board employees. Currently there are 113 certified preceptors and 21 Administrators-in-Training (AIT).

Once the training is complete and a license is issued, the Administrators must obtain continuing education credits to retain their licenses. The tracking of these credits and the monitoring functions associated with licensing and regulation are also the responsibility of the Board's staff.

The tasks associated with the licensing and regulation functions of the agency are performed by one full-time and one part-time position.

The greatest need of the agency is the retention of qualified and experienced staff. The positions of the agency are under-paid for the functions performed. The Board has continually requested that the salary of these positions be commensurate with the responsibilities performed.

To support a pay increase for the Executive Director position, the Board has conducted numerous salary surveys. The salary surveys support our request to increase the salary of this position. The average minimum compensation for Nursing Home Administrative Directors in the surrounding southern states is \$58,958. The average starting salary for other small regulatory boards in Mississippi is approximately \$53,000. We have provided the starting and ending salaries for Mississippi boards and commissions below to further demonstrate the disparity of the salaries of agencies of a similar size performing similar functions. Please note that our position is at the bottom of the list and its ending salary is less than some of the other starting salaries.

The Board recently voted to request that the salary of its Executive Director be raised to \$53,102 and submitted this information to the State Personnel Board for concurrence. We are seeking legislative authority to implement this Board action.

The second position of the Board is part-time in name only as this employee has been authorized by the State Personnel Board to work 39 hours a week. Upon the request of our Board, the State Personnel Board recently completed a review of this support position and they determined that the position was not properly classified. During the course of this review two job classifications were discussed and although the final recommendation was that the position be a Licensing Registration Agent III, we are requesting that the position be a Special Projects Officer IV as the duties and the salary of that classification are closer to the level the Board has determined it wishes to compensate this position. The Board is seeking legislative authority to reallocate this position and have the salary set at \$36,177.

Since the Board generates all its revenues from fees and has the revenue to implement the salary increases, we respectively request that approval be given to implement these personnel actions.

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The Board meets on a quarterly basis but from time to time the Board may need to meet more often to take up discipline cases. The Board is asking for the travel to be set at \$3,000 for in-state travel to meet the expenses incurred during these Board meetings and \$2,000 for out-of-state travel for the express purpose of a Board appointee attending one of the two national board meetings.
