The Board of Chiropractic Examiners is a self-funded agency. The Board operates on the fee schedules of license renewal, examination, etc., and does not receive any federal or state funds. The Board has increased the renewal fee schedule for the doctor to compensate for increases in intra-agency costs. Presently, there is approximately \$144,000 in the state treasury, which is designated to the Board of Chiropractic Examiners.

Budget for FY15 is increased over FY14. Salary and wages are increased because of the necessity of hiring another contractor to assist the Executive Secretary with changes with MAGIC plus the new laws the Legislature has for the Board to do each year. The workload is such that one person can not continue to do the work in a timely manner.

Increase in Travel is because of increase in special meetings for hearings and other items that cannot be completed at Board meetings. Per diem and travel will both go up with more meetings.

Increase in Contractual is because of increases in billing from DFA, Attorney General's office, SAAS, MMRS, and the new MAGIC, as well as postage and hearings.

Commodities are increased because of having to have paper supplies for hearings, etc.

Funding at \$73,365 is the minimum needed for the Board to operate and protect the public at the same time. This amount is under the expected revenue of \$75,000 this year. Public safety will be seriously compromised with a lower budget. The Board's ability to do the job the Legislature has mandated will be undermined with any decrease in funding.

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners has set-up operations under 2 program:

- 1. Licensure and Regulation
- 2. Examination

We estimate these 2 programs on a 70/30 ratio.

- 1. 70% Licensure and Regulation
- 2. 30% Examination

License renewals are collected annually. We examine 4 times per year on the 4th Thursday in January, April, July, and October.

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners is allowed to hire an Executive Secretary. The Executive Secretary is paid as a contractual worker through SPARHS with a contractual agreement with the full Board approval.
