### STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

1. Health Care Expendable Funds are used by MSH for the care and treatment of patients and are accounted for in a separate treasury fund (#3399).

### **OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS**

1. Medicaid receipts consist of the standard Medicaid payments received for patient care activities by Jaquith Nursing Home, Whitfield Medical Surgical Hospital, Oak Circle Center (Child and Adolescent Acute Psychiatric). The amount of Medicaid receipts from the nursing home is primarily dependent on the level of Medicaid allowable costs as confirmed by the nursing home's annual Medicaid Cost Report and the number of residents who are certified to receive Medicaid assistance. The level of Medicaid revenues for the service units of Mississippi State Hospital is determined by the individual patient's needs and their Medicaid status.

2. Medicaid Disproportionate Share (DSH)/Upper Payment Limit (UPL) is revenue derived from a payment system which compensates hospitals who provide care to a "disproportionate share" of indigent patients. Closely associated with DSH is a second payment called "Upper Payment Limit" which compensates hospitals for treating a large share of Medicaid and indigent patients at rates that are less than those paid by Medicare.

3. Medicare Receipts are collections from applicable services that are covered by Medicare. The Whitfield Medical Surgical Hospital and Inpatient Services Male and Female receiving units are all certified to participate in Medicare.

4. Other funds in this section include patient fees from benefit payments, grants from the Department of Mental Health Central Office, and educational grant funds.

### I. Program Description:

The Institutional Care Program provides a comprehensive range of inpatient psychiatric services designed to serve the needs of individuals between the ages of 4 and 12 (children), individuals between 12 years and 17 years and 11 months (adolescents), and individuals 18 years of age or older (adults), who reside in any of the ten community mental health regions assigned to Mississippi State Hospital's catchment area. Mississippi State Hospital operates a chemical dependency unit for adults and is the statewide service facility for forensic services. In addition, the hospital operates acute and continued care psychiatric units, dual diagnosis (mental retardation/mental illness) units, a medical surgical hospital, a certified nursing facility, and an acute child/adolescent psychiatric unit designed to provide diagnostic evaluation and short-term treatment for children and adolescents with impaired emotional, social, psychological and academic functioning. Many units at Mississippi State Hospital also serve as training facilities for professionals interested in the provision of services to the mentally ill.

Patients admitted to Mississippi State Hospital's Institutional Care Program may receive the following services: medical evaluation and treatment, psychiatric evaluation and treatment, psychological evaluation and treatment, social services, dietary, educational, recreational, physical therapy, music therapy, job training, vocational rehabilitation, occupational therapy, residential living, and pastoral care. Mississippi State Hospital is licensed by the State Department of Health and is fully accredited by the Joint Commission and certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

It is important to note that with the closing of Program 2 - MI - Pre/Post Instutional Care in FY 14, program output two, Community Integration Program Participants (number of), was moved to Program 1 - MI - Institutional Care for FY 15 and forward. Therefore, there was no actual output recorded for this measure in FY 14 for Program 1.

### II. Program Objective:

The objective of the Institutional Care Program is to operate a health care complex that provides a comprehensive range of high quality services to meet the needs of individuals with serious mental illnesses or individuals who require nursing home care and which meets the standards set by regulatory, licensing, and accrediting agencies or organizations. In recent years, there has also been extensive work toward serving patients in less restrictive settings than MSH. In accomplishing this objective, it has resulted in the hospital's population being the more difficult (behaviorally and medically) patients for which to care and serve.

### III. for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03 A: (D) Increase in Spending Autho:

The increases in spending authority noted here is a reflection of the authority needed to cover actual expenditures for this program. These expenditures cover services and purchases necessary for ongoing operations. The increase is being included because, in part, MSH has not been allocated adequate Other Special Fund spending authority to cover actual expenditures. If the hospital were able to obtain an increase in special fund authority, this would reduce the likelihood of submitting escalations during the fiscal year.

The \$9,898 increase in the Travel category, Other Special Funds spending authority, is for travel related to regulatory and technical trainings where the hospital staff has a need to stay updated. It will also be used for paying mileage in areas where a vehicle purchase would be unjustified.

The \$3,202,145 increase in the Contractual Services category, Other Special Funds spending authority, is for estimated services necessary for ongoing operations or expenditures that have been postponed in prior years.

The \$2,056,917 increase in the Commodities category, Other Special Funds spending authority, is for estimated purchases for necessary supplies for maintenance and repairs for ongoing operations.

The \$1,363 increase in the Other than Equipment category, Other Special Funds spending authority, is for side walk repairs, construction of concrete ramps and fencing around the hospital. Also, included in this estimated expenditure is an expected increase in a service contract related to leased equipment.

The \$21,385 increase in the Equipment category, Other Special Fund spending authority, is for purchasing new

equipment. Most of the equipment currently in use is badly worn, obsolete, and non-repairable. Many of the replacement items are for direct patient use and are essential to their improvement and programming.

The \$85,610 increase in the Vehicles category, Other Special Funds spending authority, is to purchase four patient transportation vehicles.

The \$1,047,726 increase in the Subsidies category (\$199,870 General Fund spending authority and \$847,856 Other Special Fund spending authority) is requested to enable Mississippi State Hospital to pay the estimated level of state share of Medicaid matching funds to the Division of Medicaid as required by law. It is noted that there is no overall increase requested for General Funds.

The Pre and Post Institutional Care program is a program of community programs and services, including a psychosocial clubhouse, two group homes, a program for the homeless mentally ill, a MICARE (Mental Illness with Chemical Addiction Recovery Environment) program, and case management services to provide linkage with regional community mental health center programs.

As of March 31, 2014, the Psychosocial Rehab portion of this program closed. On April 30, 2014, the remaining portions of this program, Residential Services and Case Management, closed. Operations for all Pre and Post Institutional Care have been discontinued as of June 30, 2014. Therefore, there are no estimations or projections for this program. As a result of the discontinuance of this program, administrative expenditures (paid from the general fund) were shifted to Program 1 - Institutional Care and Program 3 - Support Services. Accordingly, the majority of expenditures were shifted to Program 1 and will be used to reinforce the provision of services to individuals in need of acute inpatient psychiatric care within the Institutional Care Program.

The United States Department of Justice began a review of the Mississippi Department of Mental Health in May of 2011. It is reasonably possible that this review may result in the implementation of changes to the way the Mississippi Department of Mental Health operates, either as a result of a consent decree or, failing that, legal action. These changes could be costly. It may be a few months, or even a few years, before the review is completed and findings are presented. The funding level requested in this budget submission may be amended as a result of this review if findings are made known before the appropriations process for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, is completed.

# I. Major Object of Expenditures

It is requested that the FY 2016 appropriation be granted with "lump sum" authority, just as the FY 2015 appropriation because this provides the agency a level of flexibility which is invaluable in meeting the challenges of the current economic climate.

In addition, most minor object codes reflect increases for FY 16. Each increase and the related totals, unless noted otherwise, is a reflection of actual expenditures for MSH. These increases are being included because, in the past, MSH has not been allocated adequate special fund authority to cover actual expenditures. If the hospital were able to obtain an increase in special fund authority, this would reduce the likelihood of submitting escalations during the fiscal year.

A. Personnel Services

1. Salaries, Wages, and Fringe Benefits (base):

The amount of \$91,740,418 is shown for Salaries, Wages, and Fringe Benefits (BASE) for fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, and is the amount projected by the State Personnel Board for 100% funding of current positions in the Variable Compensation Plan Cost Continuation Projection. After adjusting for additional compensation of \$5,851,946 and deducting the proposed vacancy rate (in dollars) of \$5,471,365, the net total requested is \$92,120,999 for FY 2016, which is a \$1,371,394 decrease from the FY 15 expected beginning allocation.

The adjustment for requested additional compensation of \$5,851,946 consists of: Reallocations: \$127,480 Reclassifications: \$1,015,730 Benchmarks: \$22,446 Overtime Pay: \$4,686,290

2. Travel:

Mississippi State Hospital requests a total of \$41,308 in travel funds for FY 2016. \$38,961 is requested for Program One, Institutional Care, and \$2,347 for Program Three, Support Services. These expenditures will be used for travel related to regulatory and technical trainings where the hospital staff have a need to stay updated. It will also be used for paying mileage in areas where a vehicle purchase would be unjustified.

B. Contractual Services - Schedule B:

A total of \$13,652,998 representing a \$3,202,145 increase is requested, all of which is Other Special Funds spending authority. Of this amount, \$13,339,426 is allocated to Program One, Institutional Care, and \$313,572 is allocated to Program Three, Support Services. The most significant of the categories of Contractual Services are:

b. Communications, Transportation, and Utilities: \$1,579,564

A Performance Contract (related to operational efficiencies) is in place at Mississippi State Hospital that has reduced the electricity and natural gas needed to operate the facility. Therefore, the amounts estimated for FY 2015 and FY 2016 are less than the expenditures during FY 2014.

f. Fees, Professional & Other: \$8,535,374

61642 Nursing Services \$849,111

Nursing services for agency contracts are expended from this area and are used because they are more cost effective than using overtime to fill necessary shifts. If the quality of service, or safety, is believed to be compromised by the use of agency, then overtime may be used.

61658 Personal Service Contract - Other Fees \$978,807

Other Fees includes operation of the food services system. Nearly one million meals are served each year at Mississippi State Hospital.

h. Information Technology: \$952,586

In an attempt to stay current with Information Technology objectives, including Electronic Health Record (EHR) mandates, this area remains a priority within contractual expenditures.

#### C. Commodities:

A total of \$7,392,610 representing a \$2,056,917 increase, all of which is Other Special Funds spending authority, is requested in this category. Of this amount, \$7,381,343 is allocated for Program One, Institutional Care, and \$11,267 is allocated for Program Three, Support Services. The bulk of the Commodities appropriation is utilized in one category, prescription drugs.

d. Professional & Scientific Supplies & Equipment: \$5,165,886

62340 Drugs - Medical Use \$3,794,925

These funds are used primarily for psychotropic drugs which are vital to the accomplishment of this hospital's mission to treat persons with mental illness. Drugs are also utilized in the care of the residents of Jaquith Nursing Home. Over the past several years the expenditures for drugs have been reduced approximately 50%. This has been accomplished mainly with the use of a preferential formulary and generic medications. With the formulary in place, the least costly group of medications is used first, unless there is convincing justification that there should be deviation. The result is a lower overall cost for drugs, with no sacrifice in the quality of service. Also, various medical and professional supplies are purchased with funds allocated to this area.

e. Other Supplies & Equipment: \$1,336,066

FY 2010 was the first year in which the new threshold of \$1,000 per unit was applied to Equipment purchases. This means that most items costing under \$1,000 which were formerly classified as equipment will now be purchased as Commodities. Most of these purchases will be classed in the category of Other Supplies & Equipment.

62450 Janitorial Supplies & Cleaning \$328,287

All of these Commodity purchases are essential to provide quality care, direct and support, for the agency's mission.

D. Capital Outlay:

1. Other Than Equipment - Schedule D-1

A total increase of \$1,363 is being requested in this area. The increase is requested as follows:

a. Land:

An increase of \$442 is being requested for this minor object code. Expenditures in this minor object code are for sidewalk repairs, construction of concrete ramps and fencing around the hospital.

b. Building:

The amount included in this minor object code relates to a service contract on leased equipment. As years pass, the amount owed on the service contract increases. A \$921 increase is being requested to offset the increase in the service contract.

A total of \$463,530 representing an increase of \$21,385 is requested in this category. Much of the equipment currently in use is badly worn, obsolete, and non-repairable. Many of the replacement items are for direct patient use and are essential to their improvement and programming.

These funds are necessary to allow for replacements in different categories as follows:

b. Road Machinery, & Other Equip \$15,638

c. Office Equipment: \$19,185

d. Information Systems Equipment: \$103,994

This request is made to purchase or upgrade data processing and telecommunications equipment at Mississippi State Hospital. This equipment is necessary to maintain the current information systems capability of the hospital. The hospital's information system capability is essential for billings to Medicaid, Medicare, and private insurance. This system also provides health records and census information and will be the source of the hospital's Electronic Health Record (EHR). Because of the short useful life and rapid improvement of such equipment, exact replacements are seldom feasible. Included in this request are computer servers which are needed to upgrade and rehabilitate the capabilities of the patient admission, tracking, and billing systems.

e. Equipment - Lease Purchase: \$270,024

The increase in this category is necessary because the principle payments on Lease Purchase transactions for capital outlay items are recorded as a Capital Outlay expenditure while the interest payment is recorded as Subsidies.

f. Other Equipment: \$54,689

This request is to purchase various pieces of equipment (new and replacement) for hospital operations.

3. Vehicles - Schedule D-3:

The total request for vehicles is \$85,610. This amount includes Betterments or Accessories (63395) of \$9,110 and an additional \$76,500 for the purchase of 2 fifteen passenger vans and 2 twelve passenger vans for patient transportation.

D. Subsidies, Loans, Grants - Schedule E:

A total of \$13,969,884 is requested in this category to fund Medicaid matching fund, cost allocation payments, and other fees and taxes. All of these funds are allocated to Program One, Institutional Care. The following items are significant and worthy of explanation:

78170 Medicaid Hospital Assessment - Disproportionate Share/UPL on OCC & WMSH

Medicaid Disporportionate Share (DSH) is part of a payment system which compensates hospitals that provide care to a "disproportionate share" of indigent patients. Closely associated with this system is a second payment called "Upper Payment Limit" which compensates hospitals who treat a large share of Medicaid patients and indigent patients at rates that are significantly less than those paid by Medicare. The corresponding revenues from DSH/UPL are shown separately in the Funding Detail (Form MBR 1-02). The requested amount for expenditure in this area is \$3,786,672.

78170 Medicare Bed Tax - Nursing Home

Effective in April 2010, the Medicaid Assessment ("Bed Tax") was applied to the nursing facilities of DMH, including Jaquith Nursing Home. The rate is applied to nursing homes based on total patient days (not just Medicaid patients) as required by Federal Law. Although the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services will allow MSH to include this tax as an allowable cost in determining the Medicaid rate, the hospital will have to pay the state share of

match on any Medicaid revenues received. Therefore, \$1,246,567 is requested for this purpose.

#### 78180 Medicaid Match

The bulk of Subsidies is used to pay the required state share of Medicaid Match. Regular Medicaid (as opposed to Disproportionate Share) consits of the standard Medicaid payments received for patient care activities by Jaquith Nursing Home, Whitfield Medical Surgical Hospital, and Oak Circle Center. The Medicaid match for these payments is computer based on the applicable federal-state split in effect at the time of payment. Beginning October 2015, the Medicaid match rate will decrease to 26.57%. As a result, a decrease has been requested for this expenses. Total amount requested is \$7,653,446.

II. Budget to be Funded as Follows:

A. Cash Balance - Unencumbered:

The cash balance unencumbered at the beginning of FY 2016 is estimated to be \$13,501,812. However, the cash unencumbered balance will be less than this amount because of the need for increased spending authority in Subsidies in FY 2015. During FY 2015, it is expected that the hospital will need over \$2,000,000 more in the Subsidies category spending authority to enable Mississippi State Hospital to pay the estimated level of state share of Medicaid matching funds to the Division of Medicaid as required by law. With FY 2015 expenses expected to be in line with FY 2014 expenses, the hospital does not possess enough spending authority appropriated in this category for FY 2015. As a result, the cash balance will be used for this purpose, and, the beginning balance for FY 2016, will be less than is estimated.

B. State Appropriations:

Mississippi State Hospital is requesting \$76,377,850 in general funds for FY 2016 operations, which is no increase from FY 2015.

C. Funds from Other Sources:

1. Federal Funds: Mississippi State Hospital receives no federal funds.

2. State Support Special Funds: Requested is funding of \$3,051,244 in this area. No increase is requested.

3. Other (Special) Funds: Patient Funds, Medicaid (Regular), Medicare, and miscellaneous sources will make up the funding for this area. Requested authority for Other Special Funds is \$46,691,525.

D. Less: Estimated Cash Available Next Fiscal Period:

The cash balance anticipated at the end of FY 2016 is estimated to be \$11,848,454. The result is a net cash usage during FY 2016 of \$5,053,650.

III. Personnel Data:

A. Number of Positions Authorized in Appropriation Bill

The number of positions requested for FY 2016: Full Time- Perm of 1,893 and Full Time-TL of 114. Total requested positions equals 2,007. These positions are requested to maintain flexibility in hiring crucial positions such as direct care and nursing.

The average annual vacancy rates for FY 2014 were determined according to the budget instructions, using actuals. The vacancy rate for FY 2016 was determined based on the number of anticipated average vacant positions.
