PERS is requesting a total of \$5,850,000 in 2016 to fund our technology system solution. As we approach the final stages of the project, PERS remains dedicated to pursuing the most economical opportunities for adequate technological support of pension benefits administration. PERS must continue to address the demands of our customers, as well as changes in technology, to effectively support the processing of pension benefits.

To date PERS has engaged L. R. Wechsler, LTD., a technology consulting firm which specializes in project management and oversight of pension fund technology solutions. Sierra-Cedar, Inc. is the implementer of the pension administration solution. Sierra-Cedar and PERS are entering the final stages of the project. PERS total budget request for 2016 is \$5,850,000, which includes \$1,000,000 in software support after the warranty period expires, \$2,000,000 in upgrades of PeopleSoft and PeopleTools, and \$850,000 in line-of business computer servers and storage arrays. The total request is a decrease from 2015 funding of \$2,550,000.
