Upgrades/ Maintenance

1. Replace all plumbing lines for HVAC

\$ 200,000.00

Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers Training Academy (MLEOTA) was constructed in 1964-65 and the original underground chiller lines for the HVAC have been in place since the construction period. To avoid interruption of services to our patrons these lines should be replaced instead of constantly requiring a patch.

3. Classroom Renovations

\$ 100,000.00

The classrooms are in need of renovation. The facility is 21 years old. The carpet is in a state of disrepair and needs replacing. Renovations of the walls are necessary which include painting and removing old wallpaper. Upgrade to the lighting, audio sound system and classroom partitions are also necessary.

4. Refurbish barracks

\$ 600,000.00

The normal length of time for commercial operations such as MLEOTA is five (5) to seven (7) years between complete renovations. The barrack space for entry level training personnel has not been refurbished since 1986. In order to provide our patrons a comfortable clean environment the barracks should be refurbished top to bottom to include floor covering, painting, furnishing and fixtures.

OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

SPECIAL FUNDS

Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers Training Academy (MLEOTA) receives a majority of its revenue from Special Funds. MLEOTA charge individuals' department for services provided by the Academy. The agency provide classrooms, materials, meals, lodging, ranges, driving platforms, instructors and equipment for training law enforcement officers. The fees generated allow the agency to accomplish the mission at a minimum cost to the State of Mississippi. Lists of fees are attached as part of the agency performance indicators and measures.

The Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers Training Academy (MLEOTA) is the largest enforcement training facility in the State of Mississippi. Basic and advanced training is provided to state, county, and municipal law enforcement agencies. In-service training is also provided to state law enforcement agencies. MLEOTA provides meals and housing for students attending these training programs. The academy has a well trained staff of professional instructors who are proficient in all aspects of law enforcement.

II. Program Objective:

II. Program Objective

The objective of the training academy is to give Mississippi law enforcement officers the knowledge and skills necessary to professionally perform the duties demanded by today's society. Law enforcement officers must be able to lawfully arrest and present evidence to assist in the successful prosecution of criminals. To accomplish these tasks, officers must have the skill sets to protect themselves, collect evidence, conduct criminal investigations, communicate with citizens of all types, and write accurate reports. MLEOTA teaches students the skills necessary to accomplish these objectives.

(D) Inflationary Increases:

Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers Training Academy (MLEOTA) is requesting a continuation of all existing programs.

The other six (6) municipal and private academies continue to have some effect on our attendance for entry level training. The current unemployment rate being high coupled with tight department budgets has led to agencies not hiring possible attendees as well as affecting advanced training. The development of part times academies, the point system, and the appeals by officers to accept some classes and their experience towards their certification are also possible explanations for our current reduction in class size.

Despite this, the other academies have not affected our ability to attract the limited attendees to in-service and advanced training. We are affected by departments shrinking budgets, which stop routinely training as the first step in combating their monetary challenges. In order to maintain enrollment, MLEOTA has moved toward providing additional advanced training classes which serve all aspects of law enforcement; supervisory instruction, in-service, train the trainer, and defensive tactics. MLEOTA's staff has developed and is providing a Certified Investigator's Program (C.I.P.), a ten (10) week 400 hour course for city, county, and state officers at no cost to their departments. The C.I.P. enrollment is currently filled to capacity. Another hurdle we are facing is the limited space. MLEOTA is constantly monitoring availability of the driving track, gym, firearm ranges and classrooms. The facility is also hard pressed for space when the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol has a trooper's school. MLEOTA does not have the opportunity to increase its budget lines for commodities and additional revenue for necessary additional food, ammo and supplies, when this occurs.

With the increase in students in the numerous state training courses, MLEOTA has a need to fully staff its facility with full-time employees utilizing its own funding sources. Currently the academy relies on four (4) personnel who are funded by the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol (MHSP). Increased retirements and staff shortages may warrant MHSP recalling those individuals if the academy cannot fund them.

(E) New PINs:

The Mississippi Law Enforcement Officer Training Academy is requesting an increase of General Funds of \$25,362 for a House Keeper Senior and \$52,431 for a DPS - Instructor/Coordinator.

We are requesting \$7,016 for reclassifications.

(H) Baffle System:

With the recent construction of the baffle system at the FBI Firing Range co-located on the MLEOTA property, the State will be assuming a greater liability regarding the safety of the residents around the campus. Therefore, we are requesting \$3,000,000 in Capital Expense Funds to construct a baffle system for the MLEOTA handgun range.

(I) Repave Driver Training Tra:

Driver training is an integral part of law enforcement. We are requesting \$245,000 in Capital Expense Funds to repave the driver training course which has fallen into a state of disrepair.

(J) Tactical Training Facility:

Today's law enforcement officer is routinely placed into situations which result in physical altercations. To better train and equip our officers, we are requesting \$200,000 in Capital Expense Funds to construct a Defensive Tactics Training Facility.

(K) Travel:

We are requesting \$7,000 in special fund authority for travel in order for our MLEOTA staff to renew and seek new instructor certifications. Thus, enabling our academy to offer more advanced classes to outside agencies, as well as MHP Troopers, which will better equip and train them for day-to-day situations. Travel funds will also enable us to offer off site training to agencies in remote parts of the state.

The Mississippi Law Enforcement Officer Training Academy is requesting an increase of General Funds of \$25,362 for a House Keeper Senior and \$52,431 for a DPS - Instructor/Coordinator.

We are requesting \$7,000 in special fund authority for travel in order for our MLEOTA staff to renew and seek new instructor certifications. Thus, enabling our academy to offer more advance classes to outside agencies, as well as MHP Troopers, which will better equip and train them for day-to-day situations. We will also be able to offer off site training to agencies in remote parts of the state with a travel budget.

With the recent construction of the baffle system at the FBI Firing Range co-located on the MLEOTA property, the State will be assuming a greater liability regarding the safety of the residents around the campus. Therefore, we are requesting \$3,000,000 in Capital Expense Funds to construct a baffle system for the MLEOTA handgun range. Driver training is an integral part of law enforcement. We are requesting \$245,000 in Capital Expense Funds to repave the driver training course which has fallen into a state of disrepair. Today's law enforcement officer is routinely placed physical altercations. To better train and equip our officers, we are requesting \$200,000 in Capital Expense Funds to construct a Defensive Tactics Training Facility.

We are also requesting \$7,016 for reclasses and \$4,659 for benchmarks in General Funds.
