Grant funds are used to fund capital expansion projects. The Port Authority is a sub-recipient of Federal CDBG funds. These funds are dispersed to the Port through the direct recipient of the funds. The MS Development Authority is the direct recipient/administrator of the funds.

TREASURY FUND/BANK

Bank accounts have been established for the day to day Port Operations. Checking accounts are used for deposits, payroll, accounts payable, construction and debt service activities. Money market and safekeeping accounts have been established for investment funds. Customer deposits are segregated into a restricted funds account.
