The Education Enhancement Funds are generated from the one cent sales tax increase passed during the 1992 Session. During FY22, MAEP was appropriated \$225,112,197 in EEF funds and will not lapse any funds.

#### **OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS**

Public School Building Funds were diverted to MAEP in FY2010, FY2011, FY2012, FY2013, FY2014, FY2015, FY2016, FY2017, FY2018, FY2019, FY2020, FY2021 & FY2022.

In FY2023, \$20,000,000 in special fund authority was included in the appropriation, however revenue from the Public School Building Fund was not received. The \$20,000,000 was added to FY2023 to reconcile to the appropriation.

A decrease of \$20,000,000 is requested due to excess authority appropriated in FY2023. The special fund authority included \$20,000,000 but there was no revenue from Public School Building Funds provided.
