## **Agency Description and Programs**

Section 31-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, established the Board of Public Contractors. The Board consists of tenmembers and funded through the receipt of license fees. House Bill 260, of the 1998 Regular Legislative Session, gave authority to the Board to distribute construction education funds to various educational entities for construction education and design training. The Construction Education funds are derived from an additional fee of \$200 for licensure and renewal of licenses as a commercial contractor; and \$25 for each Residential license renewal, civil penalties, and rent collected.

Section 73-59-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, created a five-member Residential Standing Committee for Residential Builders and Remodelers, which consists of two residential builders who serve on the Board and three additional residential builders appointed by the Governor.

## 1. Licensure and Regulation

This program reviews applications for certifications of responsibility by contractors seeking to do business within the state for Private Construction in excess of \$10,000, Public Construction in excess of \$50,000, and Residential Builders and Remodelers in excess of \$50,000 and \$10,000 respectively.
