Agency Description and Programs

Section 59-17-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, established the Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority. The State Inland Ports Act authorized the Mississippi Agricultural and Industrial Board (Mississippi Development Authority), the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, and the Tennessee Valley Authority to participate in the development of a port facility, and to cooperate in the planning, acquisition, financing, construction, and operation of such an inland port on Yellow Creek in Tishomingo County, Mississippi and in the industrial development of land acquired by the State of Mississippi for that purpose. Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority is responsible for ensuring that the port facilities are promoted, operated, and maintained with the objective of becoming financially self-sustaining. It is also responsible for the promotion and development of the industrial area with the objective of locating industries thereon that will foster the economic development of Northeast Mississippi and protect the state's investment in the land.

1. Terminal Operations

This program maintains and promotes the Yellow Creek Port Terminal operations. The movement of commercial products through the terminal provides to customers the use of cheaper water transportation and encourages industry to locate in the area.

2. Industrial Development and Marketing

This program is responsible for developing industrial sites on state-owned lands for the purposes of locating industry in the Northeast area of the state. The Port Authority is vested with the responsibility to develop and market approximately 1700 acres of state-owned land in this area with the overview of the Mississippi Development Authority, Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District, and the Tennessee Valley Authority.
