Agency Description and Programs

Senate Bill 3059 of the 2020 Regular Legislative Session appropriated funds to the Mississippi Veterans Affairs - COVID-19 Funds for the purposes of addressing the public health emergency and related issues due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. These funds are part of the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or the "CARES Act" and are appropriated out of the Budget Contingency Fund.

1. COVID-19 Funds

This program provides \$10,000,000 from the Budget Contingency Fund to the Mississippi Veterans Affairs for the purpose of defraying expenses due to COVID-19. If any of the funds appropriated from the Budget Contingency Fund under Senate Bill 3059, 2020 Regular Legislative Session, have not been expended or are considered ineligible to be expended by December 15, 2020, shall be transferred into the Unemployment Compensation Fund no later than December 30, 2020.
