Agency Description and Programs

Senate Bill 3052 of the 2023 Regular Legislative Session appropriated funds to the Department of Finance and Administration to fund the Independent Schools Infrastructure Grant Program as established in Senate Bill 2780 of the 2022 Regular Legislative Session. These funds are part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) and were appropriated from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund (CSFRF). These funds are anticipated to be spent by December 31, 2026.

1. Independent K-12 School Grant

This program provides \$10,000,000.00 to the Independent Schools Infrastructure Grant Program administered by the Department of Finance and Administration to reimburse costs to eligible independent schools for investments in water, wastewater, stormwater, broadband, and other eligible infrastructure projects.
