Agency Description and Programs

The Local Provider Innovation Grant Program was created under Section 41-139-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, to strengthen and improve the healthcare system and increase access to healing care providers to help communities achieve and maintain optimal health by providing transitional assistance to providers. Grant applicants must show evidence that the provider played an active role in the community to combat the spread of COVID-19.

During the 2022 Regular Legislative Session, the Legislature appropriated \$25,000,000.00 to the State Department of Health – Local Provider Innovation Grant Program to operate this grant. These funds were appropriated through the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Funds (CSFRF). These funds are anticipated to be spent by December 31, 2026.
