STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

House Bill 48 of the 2009 Second Extraordinary Session appropriated \$481,000 out of the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Funs for the purpose of defraying the expenses of special judges, chancellors and circuit judges for FY2010. In December 2009, \$24,050 of these funds was transferred to the Budget Contingency Fund, leaving a balance of \$456,950 which was used to offset the expenses of the Trial Judges during FY2010.

Senate Bill 2495 of the 2010 Regular Session appropriated \$929,000 from the Budget Contingency Fund to the Trial Judge budget. \$400,000 of these funds was used to offset the expenses of the Trial Judges during FY2010.

OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

House Bill 1618 of the 2010 Regular Session appropriated \$400,000 from the Criminal Justice Fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of special judges, chancellors and circuit judges in FY2011. Due to decreased revenues received by the Criminal Justice Fund only \$347,109 was transferred to tht Trial Judges Budget in FY2010, of which \$294,729 was used for trial judge expenses.

TREASURY FUND/BANK

Fund 3054, Trial Judge Criminal Justice Fund, was established in Senate Bill 3078 of the 2002 Regular Session. This fund recieves transfers from the Criminal Justice Fund (#3086) as appropriated by the State Legislature.

I. Program Description:

Mississippi's trial court system consists of two general jurisdiction courts (circuit and chancery) and three (3) limited jurisdiction courts (county, juvenile, and municipal). Twenty (20) chancery courts have jurisdiction over matters involving equity, divorce, alimony, probate, guardianship, and sanity. Chancery courts have exclusive jurisdiction over juvenile matters where there are no county courts. Their jurisdiction over equity matters involving less than \$200,000 is concurrent with county courts. Most chancery court cases are non-jury proceedings, although juries may be impaneled in certain circumstances. Twenty-two (22) circuit courts have original jurisdiction over all civil and criminal matters not vested exclusively in another court. Most circuit court cases are heard by juries, although some circumstances may permit bench trials. Circuit judges also have the power to issue extraordinary writs.

II. Program Objective:

The objective of this program is the direct support of the constitutionally mandated duties of the trial judges of this state and related personnel. In Fiscal Year 1992, The Department of Finance & Administration transferred the administrative duties and management of funds to the Supreme Court. Such transfer enlarges the program objective to include statewide fiscal management of the salary and support features included in this funding.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 11 Estimated & FY 12 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) Salary:

We are requesting an increase of \$304,930 in salaries.

\$194,700 is needed to fully fund three new trial judge positions for an entire fiscal year (judges were only employed 6 months in FY2011).

\$110,230 is required to fund the support staff for the three new trial judges for an entire fiscal year. This calculation is based upon each judge receiving \$73,500 for their support staff. The support staff funding is actually set by statute at \$80,000 per judge.

(E) Travel:

An increase of \$580,000 is requested for in-state and out-of-state travel.

In-state travel of \$475,000 (increase of \$450,000) is requested to allow the 102 judges to travel to court in locations throughout their district, including meals, mileage and lodging. In FY2011, \$25,000 was appropriated for in-state-travel for 102 judges. An appropriation of \$475,000 will provide each judge with approximately \$388 per month for in-state travel.

\$130,000 is requested for out-of-state travel to allow judges to attend classes and seminars sponsored by the National Judicial College, American Academy of Judicial Education, Mississippi Bar, American Bar Association, Fifth Circuit Federal Court District, Mississippi\Louisiana\Arkansas judicial brances, etc. FY2011 is an election year and included in this amount is \$81,000 to allow for an anticipated 27 new judges to attend training sponsored by the National Judicial College. This training is required for all new judges at the Court. No funds were appropriated for out-of-state travel in FY2011.

(F) Contractual Svcs:

\$ 102,932 is requested in this category. No funds were appropriated for this category in FY2011.

- \$ 2,030 is requested for the rent of exhibit space and conference rooms utilized for training purposes throughout the year.
- \$ 31,225 is requested for SAAS and MMRS charges. The Department of Finance and Administration issued a memo which projected SAAS fees to be charged to the Trial Judges at \$4,225 and fees for MMRS at \$27,000 in FY2012.
 - \$ 1,500 is requested to cover the cost of court reporters.
 - \$ 10.101 is requested to cover the Trial Judges portion of the Tort Claims Assessment in FY2012.

\$ 28,143 is requested for dues in FY2012. Dues paid to the National Center for State Courts is shared equally by the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, AOC and the Trial Judges.

\$ 29,933 is requested for the Westlaw contract for on-line legal research. This subscriber agreement allows judges, staff attorneys and law clerks to access Westlaw and CD-ROM libraries for legal research purposes. These on-line research charges are shared with the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and Administrative Office of Courts.

(G) Commodities:

\$618,000 is requested in commodities for the Trial Judges. No funds were appropriated for this category in FY2011. The office allowance is set by statute at \$9,000.00 for each of the 102 trial judges and the rent allowance is set by statute at \$4,000.00 annually per judge. (Trial judges are allowed an office space allowance if no county space is provided to them; there are an estimated 27 judges eligible for the office space allowance.)

However, for the calculation of the funding needed for FY2012, the office allowance for each judge was reduced to \$5,000 and the rent remained at \$4,000.

\$631,545 represents the total percentage reduction as required by the budget contingency fund. A reduction of this amount from the salaries portion of the Court's budget will affect the agency's ability to pay for the support staff of the Trial Judges. The support staff allowance for each judge is set by statute at \$80,000 however due to the decrease in funding received for the Trial Judges in FY2010, the allowance has been reduced to \$73,500 per judge. A further reduction in this category would reduce the amount available to each judge to approximately \$67,100 resulting in the layoff of personnel or a greater financial burden to the counties.

Mississippi's trial court system consists of two general jurisdiction courts (circuit and chancery) and three (3) limited jurisdiction courts (county, juvenile, and municipal). Twenty (20) chancery courts have jurisdiction over matters involving equity, divorce, alimony, probate, guardianship, and sanity. Chancery courts have exclusive jurisdiction over juvenile matters where there are no county courts. Their jurisdiction over equity matters involving less than \$200,000.00 is concurrent with county courts. Most chancery court cases are non-jury proceedings, although juries may be impaneled in certain circumstances. Twenty-two (22) circuit courts have original jurisdiction over all civil and criminal matters not vested exclusively in another court. Most circuit court cases are heard by juries, although some circumstances may permit bench trials. Circuit judges also have the power to issue extraordinary writs.

For FY 2012, a total of \$24,128,374 is requested. This is an increase of \$2,676,882 or 12.47% above the FY2011 appropriation. A summary of this request is as follows:

Personal Services - Salaries

A total of \$22,394,442 is requested for this category which is an increase of \$967,950 or 4.51% above the FY2011 appropriation. The overall request includes funding for one-hundred two (102) trial judge salaries, senior status and special judge appointments, Complaint Tribunal per diem, special judge appointments for Katrina related cases and an annual support staff allowance per judge. Trial judge salaries are set by statute.

\$194,700 is requested to fully fund the three (3) new trial judges for an entire fiscal year (these positions were only filled for 6 months in FY2011). \$773,250 is required to reinstate all trial judge support staff to \$80,000.00 per year (increased from \$73,500 in FY2011).

Personal Services - Travel

\$605,000 is requested in this category, which is an increase of \$580,000 above the FY2011 appropriation.

In-state travel of \$475,000.00 (an increase of \$450,000) is requested to allow judges to travel to court in business throughout their district, to include meals, mileage, and lodging. In FY2011, \$25,000 was appropriated for in-state travel for 102 judges. An appropriation of \$475,000 will provide each judge with approximately \$388 per month for in-state travel.

\$130,000.00 is requested in Out-of-state travel to allow the trial judges the ability to attend classes and seminars sponsored by the National Judicial College, American Academy of Judicial Education, Mississippi Bar, American Bar Association, Fifth Circuit Federal Court District, Mississippi/Louisiana/Arkansas judicial branches, etc. FY2011 is an election year and included in this amount is \$81,000 to allow for an anticipated twenty-seven (27) new judges taking office to attend training sponsored by the National Judicial College. This training is required for all new judges at the Court. No out-of-state travel funds were appropriated in FY2011.

Contractual Services

\$102,932 is requested in this category. No funds were appropriated for this category in FY2011.

\$2,030 is requested for the rent of exhibit space and conference rooms utilized for training purposes throughout the year.

\$31,225 is requested for SAAS and MMRS fees. The Department of Finance and Administration issued a memo which projected SAAS fees to be charged to the Trial Judges at \$4,225 and MMRS fees at \$27,000 in FY2012.

\$1,500 is requested for the cost of court reporters.

\$10,101 is requested to cover the Trial Judge portion of the Tort Claims Assessment in FY2012.

\$28,143 is requested for dues in FY2012. Dues paid to the National Center for State Courts are shared equally by the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, AOC and the Trial Judges. These dues are mandatory for the Court.

\$29,933 is requested for the Westlaw contract for on-line legal research. This subscriber agreement allows judges, staff attorneys and law clerks to access Westlaw and CD-ROM libraries for legal research purposes. These on-line research charges are share with the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals and AOC.

Commodities

\$1,026,000 is requested in the commodity category for trial judge office operating and office space allowances. No funds were appropriated in this category for FY2011. The office allowance is set by statute at \$9,000 for each of the 102 trial judges and the rent allowance is set by statute at \$4,000 annually per judge. (Trial judges are allowed an office space allowance if no county space is provided to them; there are an estimated 27 judges eligible for the office space allowance.)
