The 2003 appropriations created a special fund for the Commission. This fund is to be used to ensure the office is fully operational by accepting fees generated from the Criminal Justice Fund.

The fees collected do not generate more than one third of the amount needed to fund the expenses of the Commission. The General Fund appropriation is needed to fully fund the Office and yet it has been decreased even though expenses have increased.

Due to these factors, the Commission must have additional General Fund revenues. In addition, the Commission's operational budget was cut by almost 15% for FY11. Numerous expenses will have to be carried over to FY12 which will not be able to be paid in FY11 - this is reflected as a budget increase in the majority of the major object categories.

OVERVIEW

The Mississippi Commission on Judicial Performance was created in 1979 by the Mississippi Legislature and the voters of the State of Mississippi by constitutional amendment. It was created for the following purposes:

- 1 To enforce the standards of judicial conduct;
- 2 To inquire into allegations of judicial disability, ethical misconduct and violation of law;
- 3 To protect the public from judicial misconduct and disabled judges; and
- 4 To protect the judiciary from unfounded allegations.

In 2009 the Commission received and processed 337 complaints against Mississippi judges, a record number. This feat was accomplished with a staff of only two attorneys and one investigator.

The Commission was traditionally funded from State General Funds as it provided a general government service. In FY06 the Commission received its first Special Fund appropriation which was generated from court assessments; the Commission receives \$2.00 on non-traffic related misdemeanor convictions. The revenue collected from these court assessments has proven to be inadequate to properly fund the Commission and provides less than one-third of the required funding for Commission operations. Due to mandated budget cuts in past several years, the special fund revenue has had to absorb additional operation expenses. Each year between FY04 and FY09, the Commission has sought and received a deficit appropriation. A deficit was not sought in FY10 solely due to the retirement of its Executive Director and having a vacancy in this position for several months.

The court assessment revenue was reduced by almost 15% in FY10. This coupled with the fact that the General Fund was reduced by five percent during the appropriation process and then another nine and half percent from the Governor's budget reductions.

The special funds cannot continue support General Fund reductions. The Commission is requesting additional General Fund revenue for its FY12 operations.

During FY11 the Commission has taken extraordinary measures to reduce its expenses. The Commission relocated its operations to smaller state-owned offices which reduced rental costs by \$10,800. We purchased a used vehicle from another state agency for approximately \$3,000 which has already reduced our investigative travel costs by \$1,000 per month. We have eliminated all out-of state travel. We have stopped all non-essential legal publication subscriptions. We are investigating cases and interviewing witnesses telephonically whenever possible and limiting investigative travel. We will continue to seek methods to reduce costs without reducing the effectiveness of the Commission.

The Commission is seeking to be fully funded in FY12 and is seeking to augment its Special Funds with a slightly increased General Fund appropriation.

PERSONAL SERVICES - SALARY

\$469,209

The Commission employs two attorneys to handle the cases of judicial misconduct. The salaries of these two employees are presently \$81,000 and \$60,000 respectively. By way of comparison, the starting salary for a staff attorney in a District Attorney's office is in excess of \$76,000 and a senior attorney's salary within the District Attorney's office is in excess of \$86,000. At this time, the Commission is requesting additional compensation for its attorneys and office manager to finally bring the salaries to a level comparable with that of a District Attorney's office.

The Commission is also seeking a slight increase in this line item in order to pay per diem for Commission meetings and also to pay for the worker's compensation.

The Commission is seeking less authority in the Travel line-item than it expended in FY10. The travel costs will be reduced due to the purchase of a used vehicle for investigative use and also since all out-of-state travel will be eliminated. The FY11 travel budget does not reflect true needs of the Commission and therefore should not be used as a measurement for FY12.

CONTRACTUAL

\$94,760

The Commission's FY12 request is slightly less than its FY10 expenditures since the agency was able to relocate its offices into less expensive state-owned office space. However other costs associated with occupying state-owned space, including but not limited to higher ITS charges, necessitate the present request. The FY11 contractual budget does not reflect true needs of the Commission and therefore should not be used as a measurement for FY12.

COMMODITIES

\$ 10,000

In order to meet budget reductions, the Commission will expend funds only for essential office supplies. The FY11 budget request did not include fuel costs as the Commission had not anticipated purchasing a vehicle for its investigator. The commodity line item must be increased for FY12 in order to fuel to be purchased and for the Commission to have supplies needed for basic office operations. The use of this vehicle has dramatically reduced overall in-state travel costs.

CAPITAL OUTLAY

\$ 9.500

The Commission did not have any equipment expenditures in FY07, FY09 or in FY10 and does not have anything budgeted for this category for FY11. Since the Commission has only expended \$2,275 in this category in the past four years, the will be a dire need for computers to be replaced in FY12. We are requesting the replace of all computers in the office and the replacement of the printer.

In order to fund this request, the Commission will be required to expend cash reserves and increase its general fund appropriation.
