To remain in compliance with the agreement, the Commission must use such funds for law enforcement purposes only, in accordance with the statutes and guidelines that govern equitable sharing. It is further stipulated that these assets may only be used to augment the law enforcement budget and not to supplant it. Therefore, the fund balance due to seized and forfeited funds can only be used above and beyond our normal operating budget.

STATE SUPPORT SPECIAL FUNDS

HB 1059 allowed for the transfer of \$1,208,932 from the Budget Contingency fund to the MS Gaming Commission. This amount was needed to allow the MGC to comply with the 2010 budget cuts. The MGC expects to repay this amount in full during FY 2011.

OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

3187 Investigations

The Mississippi Gaming Commission has adopted regulations that authorize the Commission to charge monies for various work products that are necessary to carry out the duties given to the Commission and to comply with Statutes set forth in the Gaming Control Act. The MGC exclusively relies on Special Fund Revenues to fund the agency. These special funds are derived from each licensed casino paying an inclusive investigative fee on a quarterly basis. This inclusive fee covers all investigations, field verfications and audits of current casino operations.

The MGC was given the authority to levy the above mentioned fee, beginning with FY 2011. During the 2010 Regular Legislative Session, House Bill 1147 ammended the Mississippi Code of 1972, Section 75-76-81 as follows: "The Mississippi Gaming Comission shall assess and collect all fees imposed under Section 75-76-33(2)(f) and shall deposit the funds received from the fees into the Mississippi Gaming Commission Fund. Unexpended amounts remaining in the special fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund."

Any other special funds are derived from laboratory fees, work permiting fees, self exclusion forfeitures and investigations conducted outside current casino operations. The investigative fund balance at the end of each fiscal year is comprised of many different elements such as carried over fund balances, unused investigative deposits, revenue in excess of estimates and balances created from budget cuts over original appropriations.

3188 Charitable Bingo

In the Gaming Control Act, the Mississippi Gaming Commission is also tasked with the oversight and enforcement of the Charitable Bingo Laws. Along with this task, the Commission was given the authority to assess various fees associated with this oversight. These fees include but are not limited to License Fees, Bingo Revenue Fees, Pull-tab Fees, and Machine Fees. Section 97-33-101 of the Charitable Bingo Law states:

"All fees and fines collected by the commission pursuant to Sections 97-33-51 through 97-33-203 shall be deposited into a special fund to be known as the "Charitable Bingo Fund," which is hereby created in the State Treasury. The monies in such fund shall be used exclusively to support the activities of the commission related to the regulation of the Charitable Bingo Law, upon appropriation by the Legislature. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on amounts in such special fund shall be deposited to the credit of the special fund."

I. Program Description:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission is charged with enforcing the law and regulating casinos with regard to the Mississippi Gaming Control Act (MS Code Ann. 1972 75-76-1 through 75-76-313).

II. Program Objective:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission seeks to maintain the integrity of the gaming industry in Mississippi. This is achieved in a two-fold method: (1) Maintain the integrity of the gaming property and (2) Maintain the integrity of the gaming patron.

III. Current program activities as supported by the funding in Columns 6-15 (FY 11 Estimated & FY 12 Increase/Decrease for continuations) of MBR-1-03 and designated Budget Unit Decisions columns of MBR-1-03-A:

(D) Personal Serices:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests an increase of \$97,998 in the Major Object Category Salaries. This additional compensation includues only career ladder reclassifications and benchmarks. This request is an important aid in our efforts to retain competent staff.

(E) Contractual Services:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests an overall increase in the Major Object Category Contractual Services of \$53,129. Of that total, \$45,159 is assigned to the Riverboat Program. This is in anticiaption of repairs and services, as well as professional fees. Full details and explanation is included in the overall budget narrative.

(F) Commodities:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission is requesting a small increase in the Major Object Category Commodities for the Riverboat Program of \$2,425. The overall request is a net decrease for this category of \$24,062. Full detail and explanation is included in the overall budget narrative.

(G) Equipment:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests no overall increase in the Major Object Category Equipment for FY 2012. However, the net effect for the Riverboat Gaming program is an increase of \$6,000. The MGC feels that this program will need to replace more aging equipment than the Charitable Gaming program.

(H) Vehicles:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests no overall increase in the Major Object Category Vehicles for FY 2012. The \$110,000 requested for FY 2012 will allow the MGC to replace the older vehicles which are in disrepair. The net effect in the Riverboat Gaming program is an increase of \$20,000.

(I) Subsidies Loans & Grants:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests an overall decrease of \$1,208,932 in the Major Object Category Subsidies, Loans and Grants. The full amount is reflected in the Riverboat Program. This was needed in FY 2011 in order to repay the monies borrowed from the Office of the Treasurer in FY 2010. This will not be needed in FY 2012.

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) is charged with enforcing the law and regulating all charitable bingo operations pursuant to the Charitable Bingo Act (Miss. Code Ann. 1972, sections 97-33-51 thru 97-33-203).

II. Program Objective

The MGC seeks to maintain the integrity of the charitable bingo operations in Mississippi. This is achieved by regulating the actual bingo halls and monitoring the channels that determine the course of the revenue earned in these establishments.

(D) Contractual Services:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) has requested an overall increase in the Major Object Catergory Contractual Services of \$53,129. Of that amount, \$7,970 pertains to the program Charitable Gaming. The majority of the increase requested is to allow for employee training that was postponed in prior fiscal years.

(E) Vehicles:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests no overall increase in the Major Object Category Vehicles for FY 2012. The \$110,000 requested for FY 2012 will allow the MGC to replace aging vehicles that are in disrepair. The net effect to the program Charitable Bingo is a decrease of \$20,000.

(F) Equipment:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a continuation budget with no increase in the Major Object Category Equipment. The net effect to the program Charitable Gaming is a decrease of \$6,000.

(G) Commodities:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests an overall decrease of \$24,062 in the Major Object Category Commodities. Due to a requested increase in other programs, the net effect on the Charitable Gaming program is a decrease of \$26,487. Complete details are in the overall budget narrative.

NARRATIVE 2012 BUDGET REQUEST

Mississippi Gaming Commission Name of Agency

The Mississippi Gaming Commission (MGC) requests a continuation budget of \$10,301,355 for Fiscal Year 2012. This request reflects an overall decrease of \$1,082,367 from our Fiscal Year 2011 appropriation. The MGC does not foresee any expansion of activities or services, but seeks to maintain the level of regulatory services necessary to carry out the responsibilities placed on the Agency in the Gaming Control Act. At the Agency's current level of funding, there are areas which need to be enhanced in order to maintain the level of integrity the State of Mississippi has established in the gaming industry's regulatory environment. A lack of funding leads to staffing shortages, limited travel and contractual funds to adequately train and develop law enforcement and auditing staff, and limited commodity funds interrupt the continuation of business.

No General Funds are requested for Fiscal Year 2012. The MGC exclusively relies on Special Fund Revenues to fund the agency. These special funds are derived from each licensed casino paying an inclusive investigative fee on a quarterly basis. This inclusive fee covers all investigations, field verfications and audits of current casino operations. Any other special funds are derived from laboratory fees, work permitting fees, self exclusion forfeitures and investigations conducted outside of current casino operations.

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests to have language in the Fiscal Year 2012 appropriation bill to continue to have the ability to escalate and expend funds from any proceeds arising from the participation in seizures of illegal gaming activities. These monies will be awarded to the Agency by the county and municipal courts. The use of the funds is limited to law enforcement purposes, excluding salaries.

The Major Object Categories affected by the budget request are detailed as follows:

PERSONAL SERVICES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission is requesting an increase of \$97,998 in the Major Object Category Personal Services. This increase is requested for anticipated reclassifications of enforcement agent and accountant/auditor professional pins, expected educational benchmarks, and maintenance of the Agency's allocated positions. Further detail will be addressed in the individual program narratives.

TRAVEL:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase/decrease in the Major Object Category Travel for Fiscal Year 2012.

CONTRACTUAL SERVICES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a \$53,129 increase in the Major Object Category Contractual Services for Fiscal Year 2012. The MGC anticipates an increase in expenditures because spending has been so minimal in the past few Fiscal Years. As with any agency comprised of law enforcement officers, specific training is mandatory in order for certifications to be maintained. The MGC also maintains several data bases that will require professional assistance in maintaining or upgrading. These items will not expand the MGC but will only allow for maintaining the level of regulatory services necessary to carry out the responsibilities placed on the MGC in the Gaming Control Act.

COMMODITIES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a decrease in the Major Object Category Commodities of \$24,062. This amount will still allow the MGC to operate all necessary functions to carry out its mission. The \$195,938 requested, while less than anticipated Fiscal Year 2011 spending, amounts to level funding and is appropriate for this category.

CAPITAL OUTLAY:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase/decrease in the Major Object Category Capital Outlay Equipment for Fiscal Year 2012.

VEHICLES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests no increase in the Major Object Category Vehicles for Fiscal Year 2012. However, in order to carry out the responsibilities placed on the Agency by the Gaming Control Act, enforcement agents, auditors, and compliance officers must frequently drive to both casinos and charitable gaming facilities for regulatory purposes. Many vehicles in the Agency's fleet have reached high mileages, which in turn, increase the amount necessary for repairs and maintenace that have to be done. The \$110,000 requested for Fiscal Year 2012 will allow the Agency to purchase approximately five vehicles and to replace some that are in disrepair approaching eight to twelve years old.

WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a decrease of \$500 in the Major Object Category Wireless Communication Devices for Fiscal Year 2012. The appropriation granted for Fiscal Year 2011 allowed the agency sufficient wireless communication devices.

SUBSIDIES, LOANS, & GRANTS:

The Mississippi Gaming Commission requests a decrease in the Major Object Category Subsidies, Loans, & Grants for Fiscal Year 2012 of \$1,208,932. This amount was included in Fiscal Year 2011 in order to allow the MGC to repay the Office of the State Treasurer the funds borrowed in Fiscal Year 2010. Those funds were borrowed in order to comply with the Special Funds budget cut. The MGC anticipates making full repayment in Fiscal Year 2011.
