EIGS works with member companies, university partners, and state agencies to research, develop, and market new geospatial technology services, products, and tools in Mississippi, the nation, and the world. EIGS accomplished these goals through a coordinated program of business services to member companies, recruiting new and complementary companies to Mississippi, facilitating research opportunities with Mississippi universities, and promoting and supporting the growth of an educated, well-trained workforce to address the needs of the geospatial industry.

The objectives of the EIGS program and its predecessor, the Mississippi Space Commerce Initiative, have been met. There is a robust and vibrant industry cluster that is growing and able to continue without direct support from the University of Mississippi. Geospatial education and research programs exist at all levels in Mississippi from the community college system through the research universities. Therefore, it is time for the EIGS program to transfer the business support to the companies. The companies have formed the Magnolia Business Alliance (MBA) that will acquire the EIGS program, without funding, from the University of Mississippi.
