Federal grants continue to assist the college in enhancing its mission. New grants are continually being sought out.

#### OTHER SPECIAL FUNDS

Tuition increased \$100 from \$974 in FY 2010 to \$1,074 in FY 2011. The tuition increase will generate approximately \$1M in revenue.

The eight county district continues to support the college with local millage. The college expects at least as much in local support for FY 2011 and FY 2012 as in FY 2010.

The college bookstore adds about \$500K to the college's bottom line which is critical to meeting expenditures throughout the year.

#### TREASURY FUND/BANK

The college uses 3 bank accounts for normal operations: payroll, accounts payable, and student refunds. A fourth account manages a bond issue and will be depleted by the end of 2011. Two additional clearing accounts were opened to segregate HRA and HSA funds.

The program provides a unique opportunity to help students develop the characteristics of success that today's business and industry embrace: clarity of purpose, emphasis on quality, teamwork, a broad technical and academic foundation for effective problem solving, decision-making, and communication at the work site.

The FY 2011 budget is extremely lean. Eight faculty members retired that will not be replaced; adjuncts will be used to fill in the gaps. Faculty and administrators suffered a 3% salary cut in order to help balance the FY 2010 budget.

The college transformed part of the library into a Student Success Center in FY 2010. Most students' needs are met at the SSC from services such as: counseling, enrollment, basic financial aid, career planning, tutoring, WiFi, and coffee shop. The entire renovation cost approximately \$300K, and the relatively small investment has proven to be far-reaching in the area of student engagement.

The president and cabinet have set a goal that by 2020, the college is rated in the top ten in the country in student engagement, a statistic that s measured by CCSSE (Community College Survey of Student Engagement). In FY 2010, the President-appointed Vision 2020 Taskforce compiled a 10-year strategic plan with student engagement as the common thread among all functions. We feel that in order to have the greatest impact on our students, we have to really know our students...we have to engage our students. Engaging our students means that we not only teach them, but we instill community awareness, encourage civics and government participation, promote a strong work ethic, and enable meaningful communication. Our engagement efforts have already proven successful as our retention and persistence rates have greatly improved. We look forward to continuing the Vision 2020 plan and making an even greater impact on our students and community as we inspire greatness.
