#### (D) SECTION 110 INCREASE:

The Section 110 Grant is used in the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation and the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind and is the Basic Support Grant from the Department of Education for rehabilitation of disabled Mississippians. This group is growing in number and the costs of services needed to rehabilitate them are increasing each year. The Federal Government accounts for these increasing numbers and costs by making more Section 110 funds available each year. We are requesting an increase in FY 2012 Office of Vocational Rehabilitation General Fund Appropriations of \$282,650 and Special Fund Authority of \$1,044,345 to cover the increase in this federal grant. Of this amount, Decision Unit C makes up \$135,366 of the requested General Fund increase and \$500,156 of the requested Special Fund Authority increase. These increased funds would be used to cover the increases in client served as well as the costs of providing services. The remaining part of the requested increase is accounted for in Decision Units E, below.

#### **Narrative Explanation:**

The majority of state funding associated with this appropriation unit is used to match the Section 110 grant which has a 21.3% match. Therefore, a cut of \$234,511 would result in a loss of federal funds of \$866,480 and a total loss to the OVR program of \$1,100,9991. The Section 110 program contains a Maintenance of Effort (MOE) requirement regarding the level of state funds utilized each year. A loss of state funding in this appropriation unit would result in our agency becoming noncompliant with this MOE requirement. As a consequence, such a reduction would not only affect our current federal grant, but would impact future year grants due to the affect on our grant base from FY2012 forward.

In addition to the loss of federal funds, this funding could require the agency to reduce its Subsidy, Loans and Grants line in this appropriation unit which involves the funding we spend on our clients throughout the State of Mississippi.
