On August 29, 2005, Hurricane Katrina struck the Mississippi Gulf Coast resulting in the costliest and the most deadly hurricane in the history of the United States. It was the sixteenth strongest Atlantic hurricane ever recorded and the third strongest land falling U. S. Hurricane ever recorded. SB 3037 afforded the establishment of the Hurricane Disaster Reserve Fund and appropriated the sum of \$268,000,000 to defray the state share of any non-federal matching requirements for Federal Emergency Management Agency grants associated with Hurricane Katrina and other disasters. At the present time, the balance remaining in Treasury Fund 37SS is \$100,550,150.
